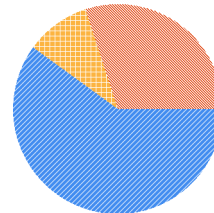

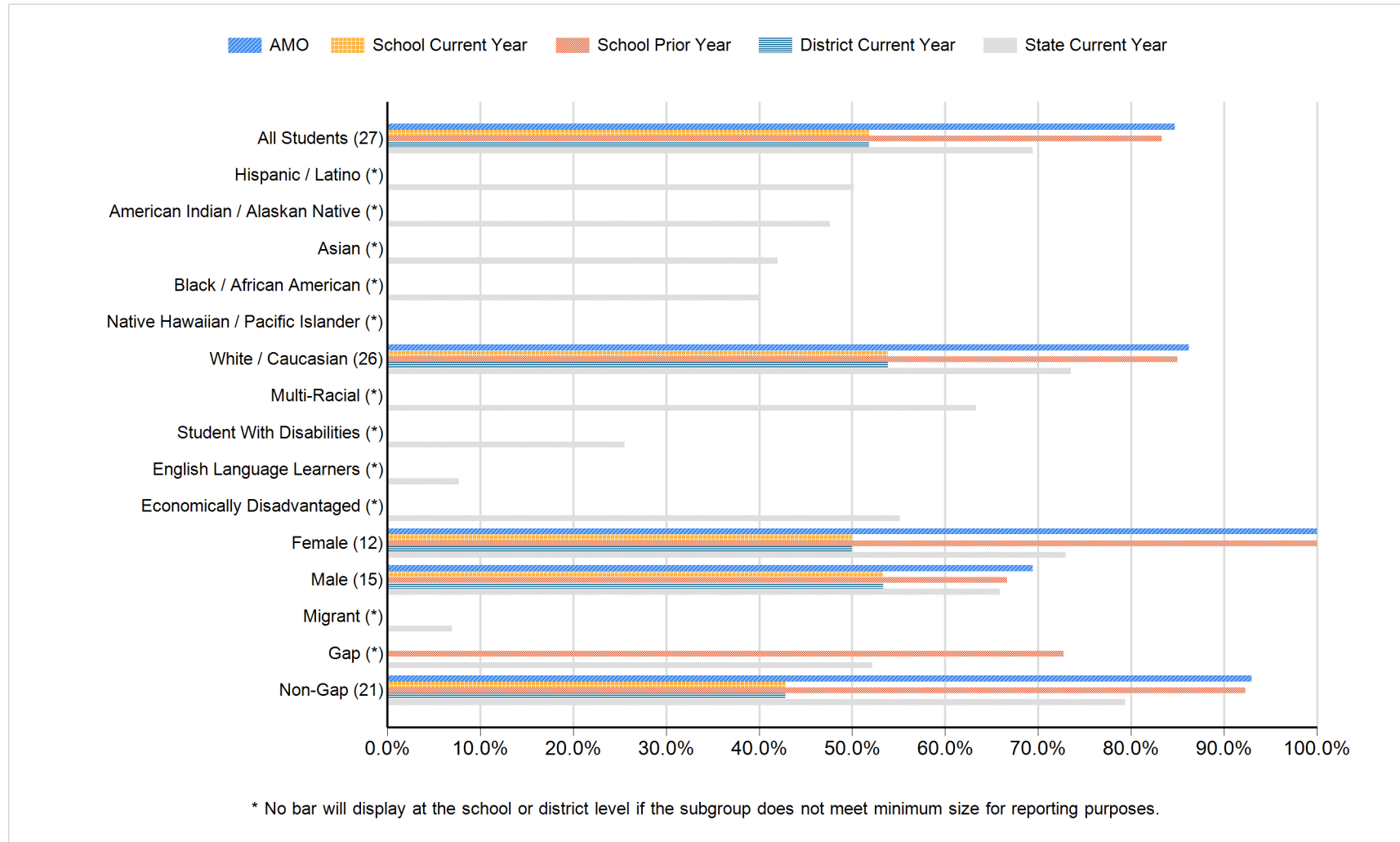
Student Population

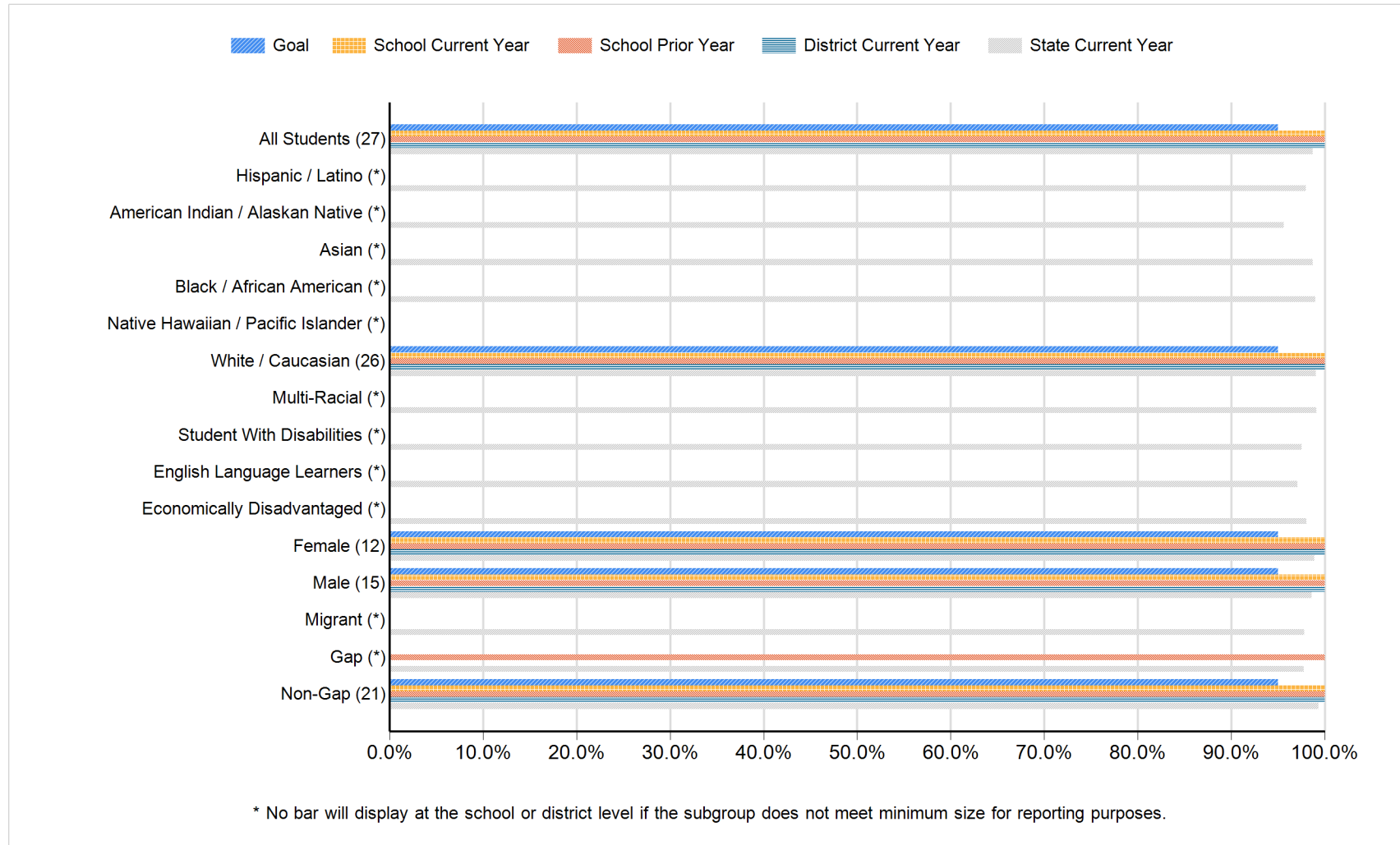

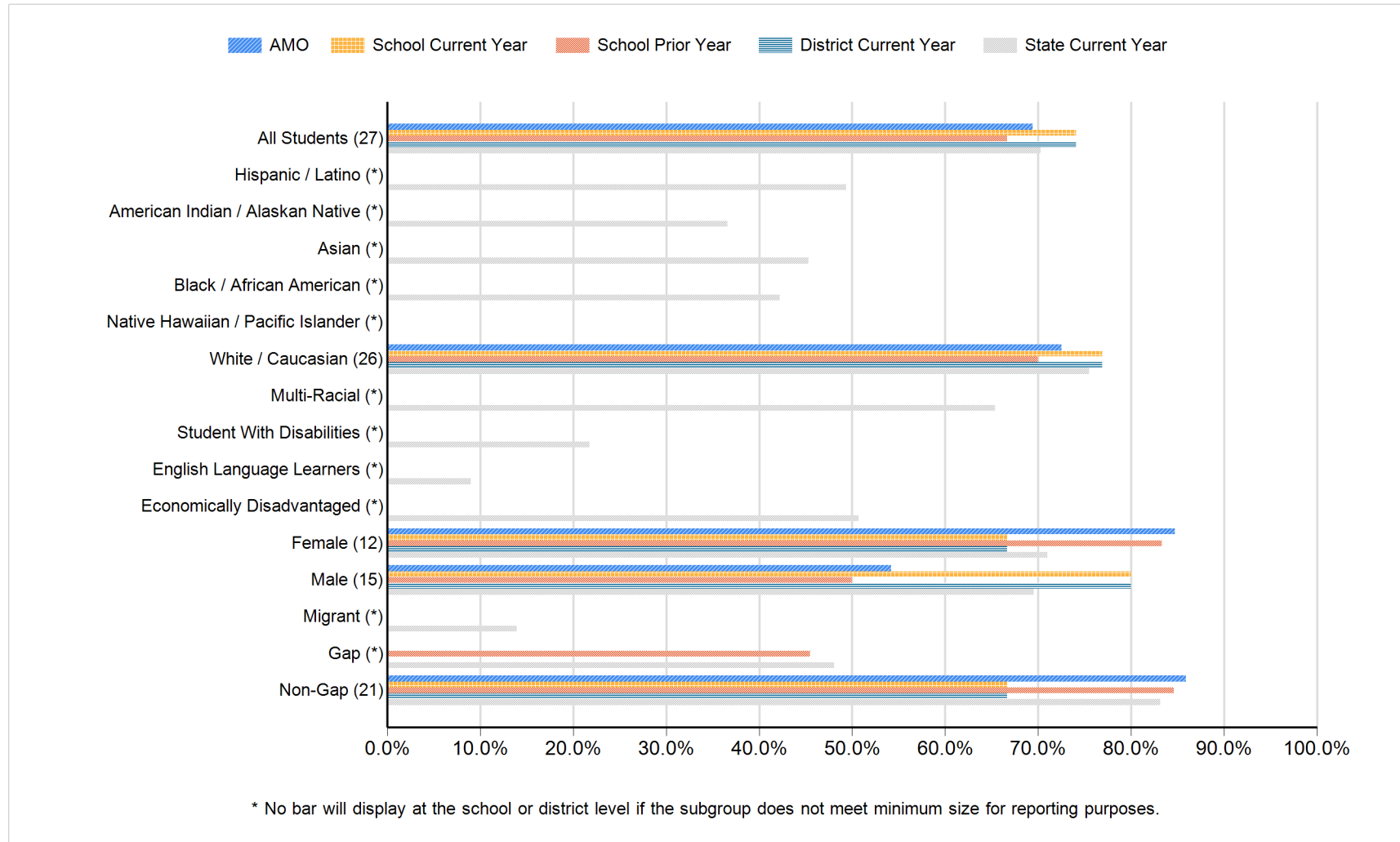

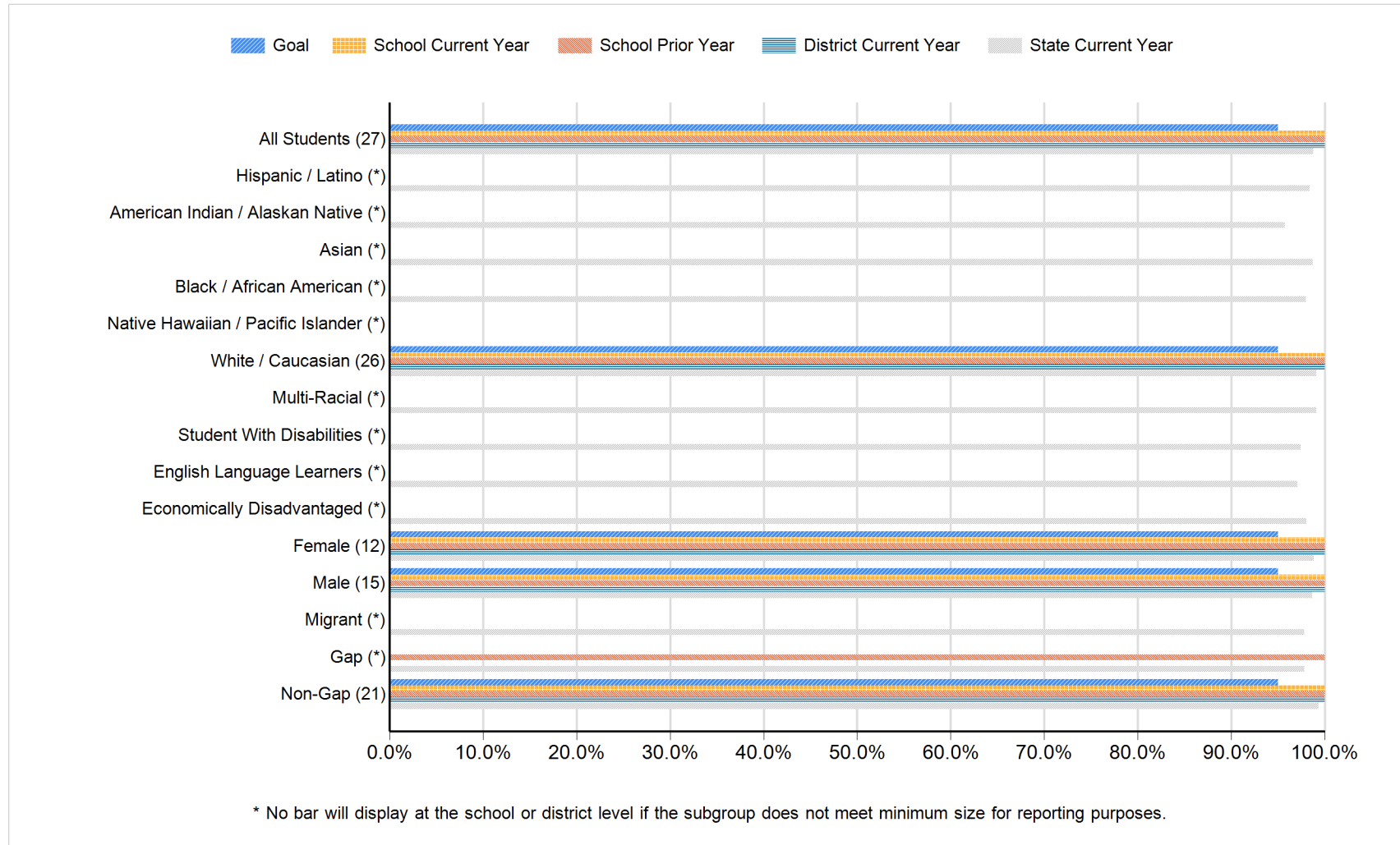

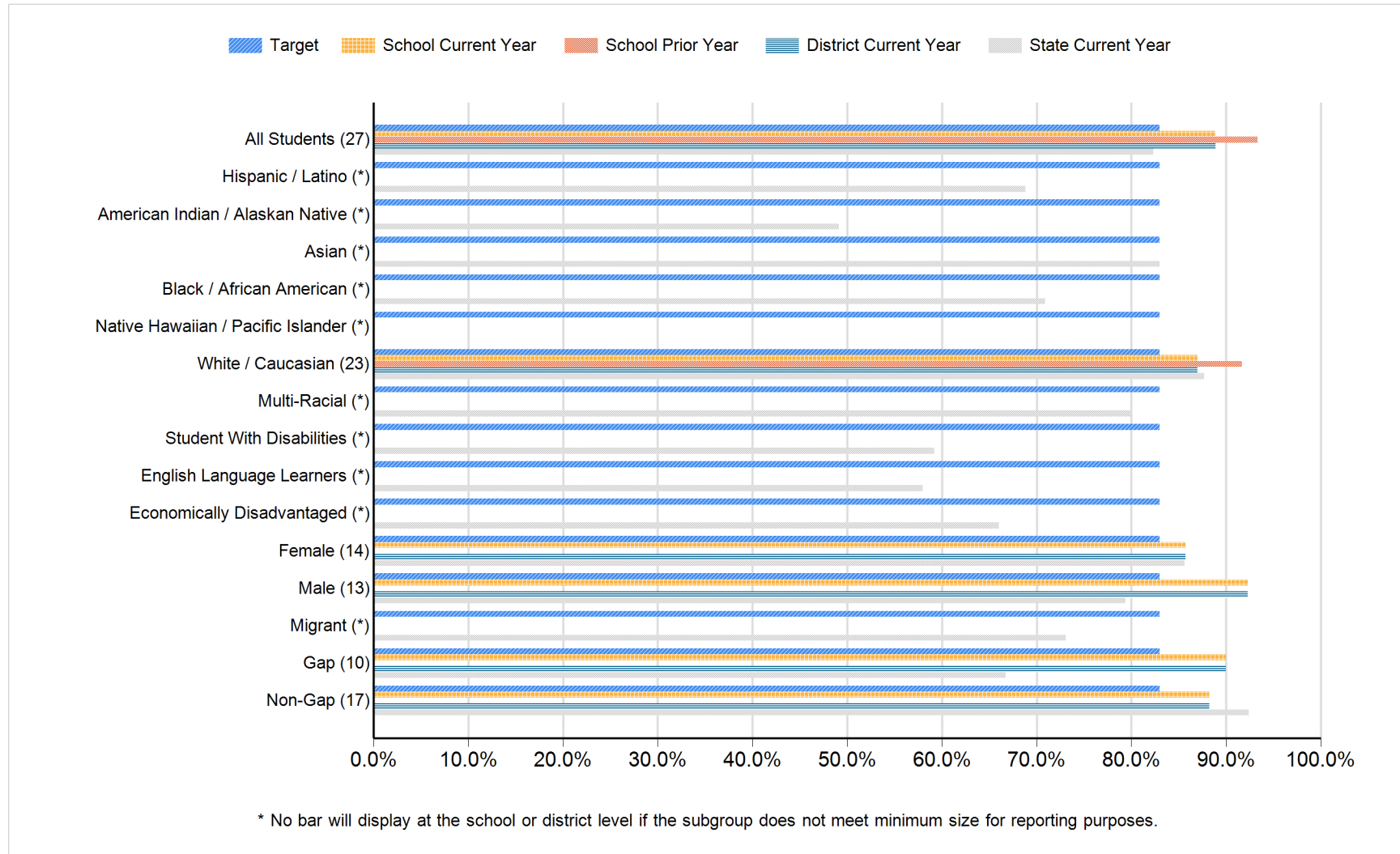

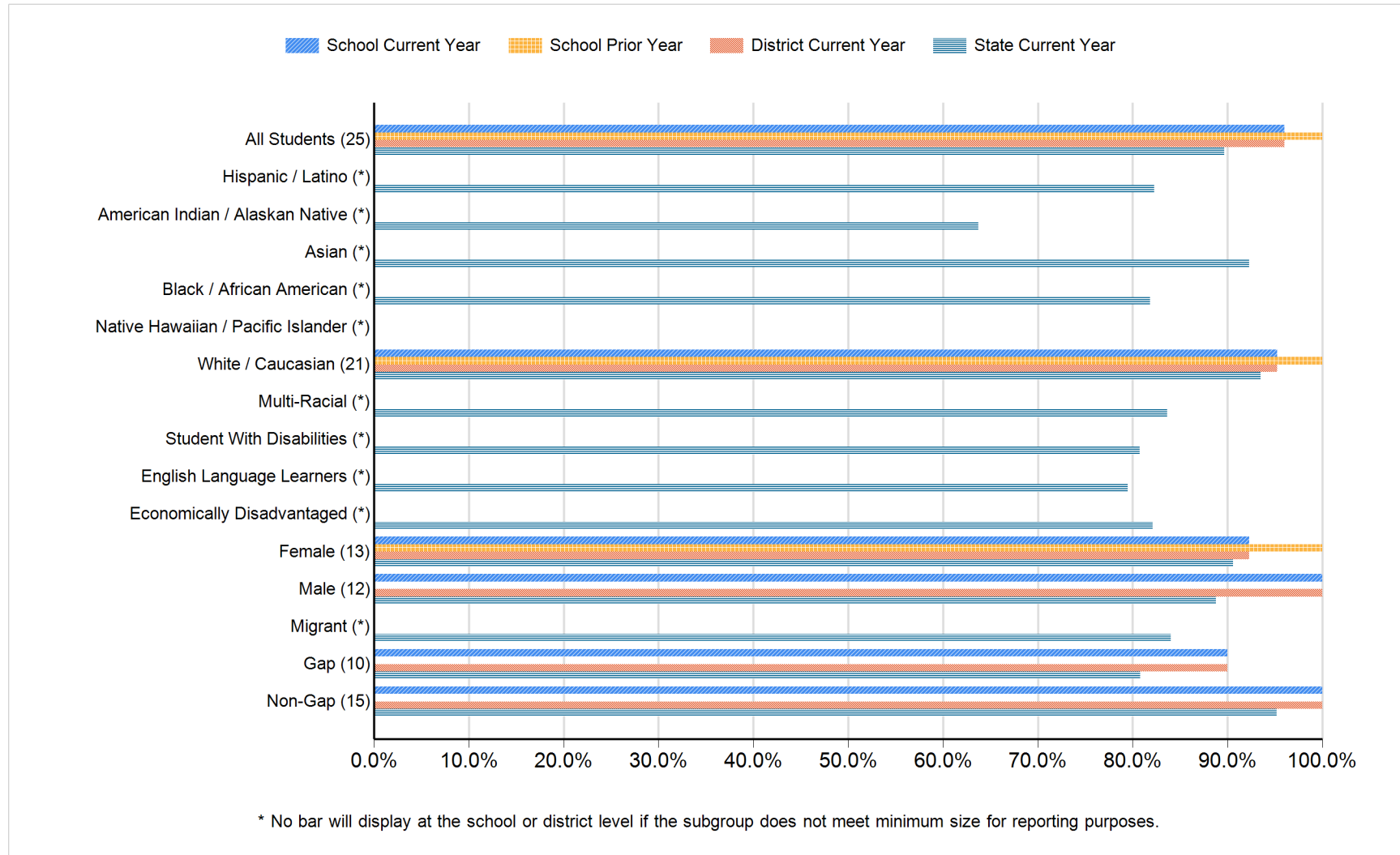

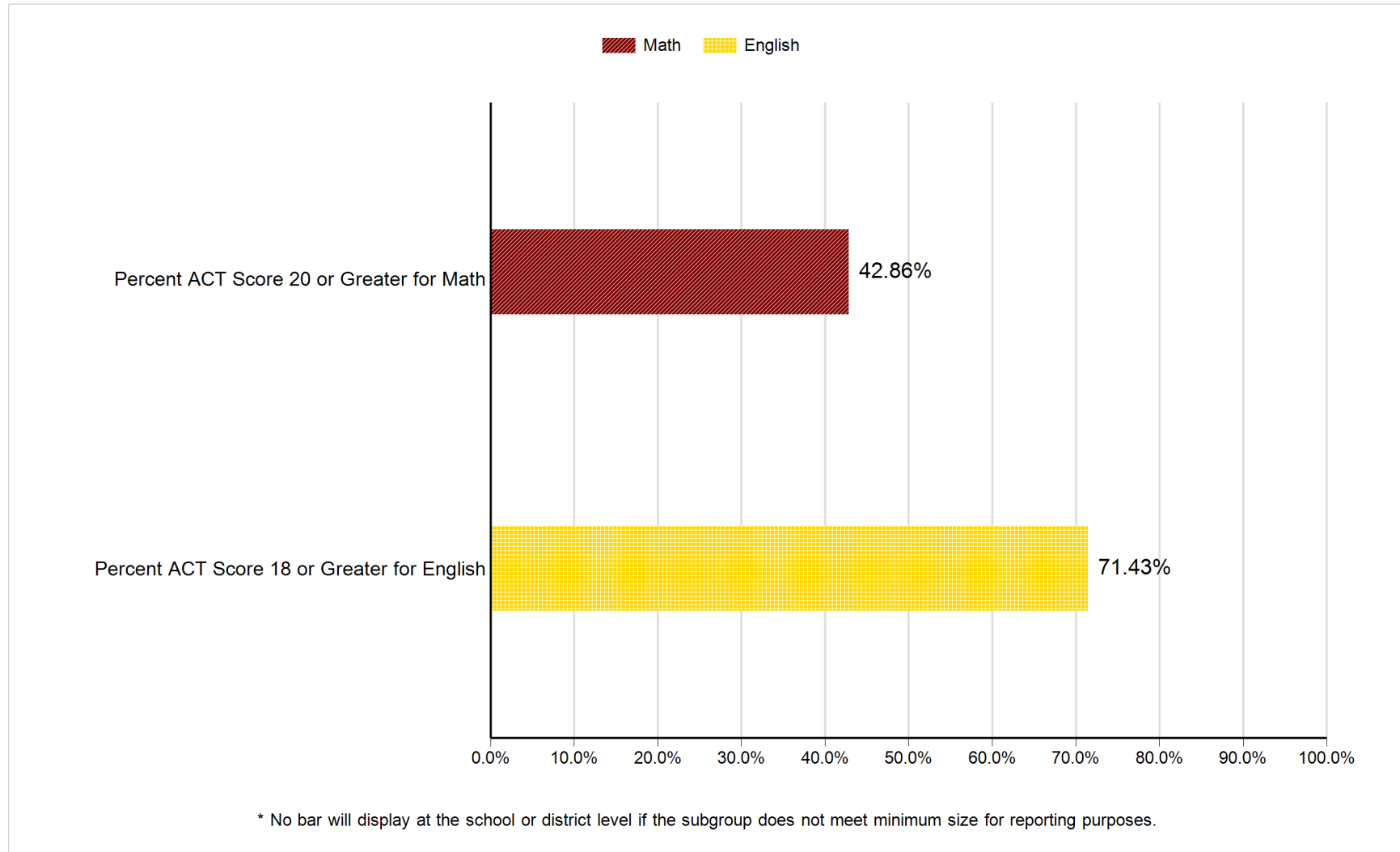
