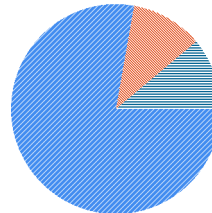

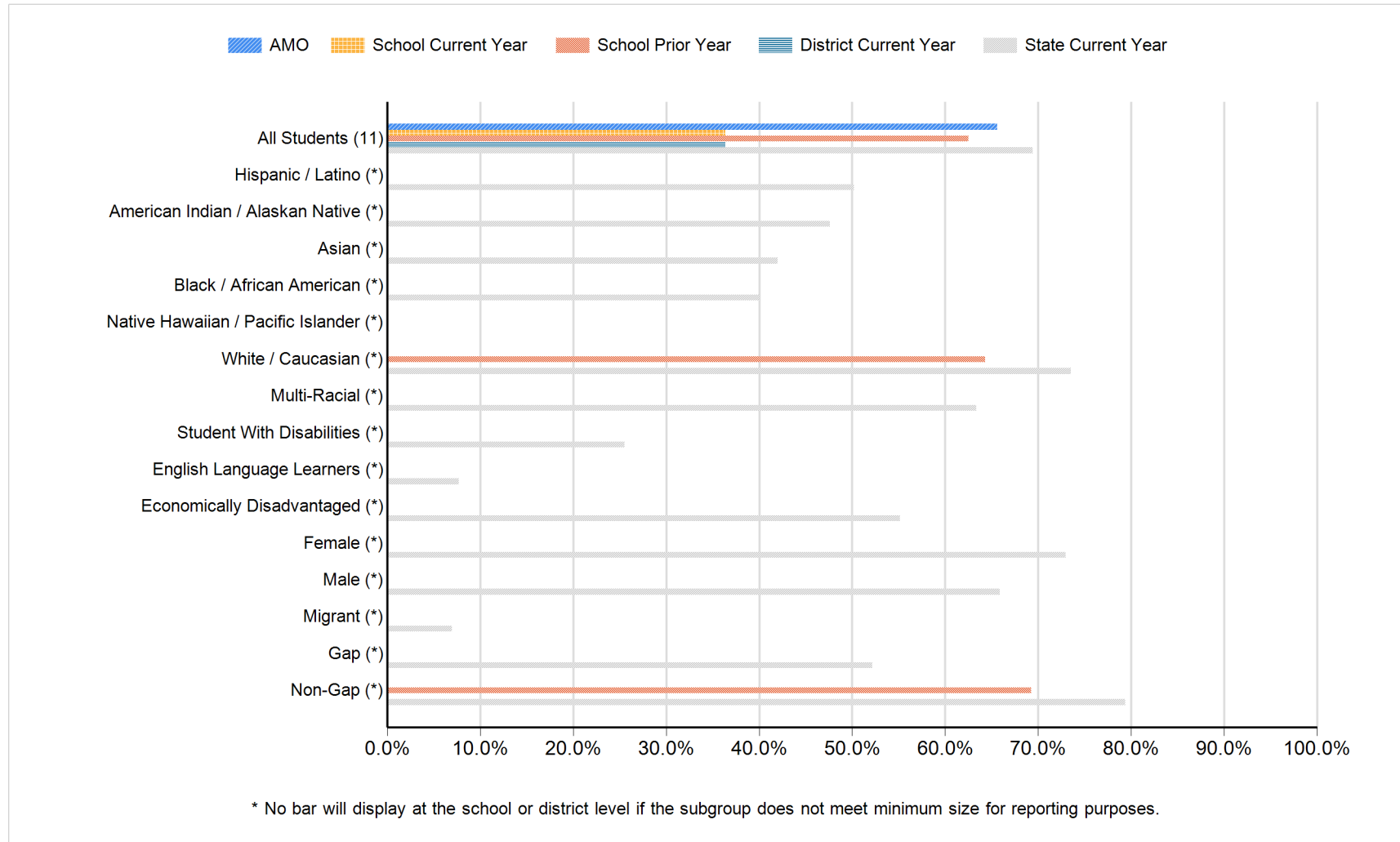
Student Population

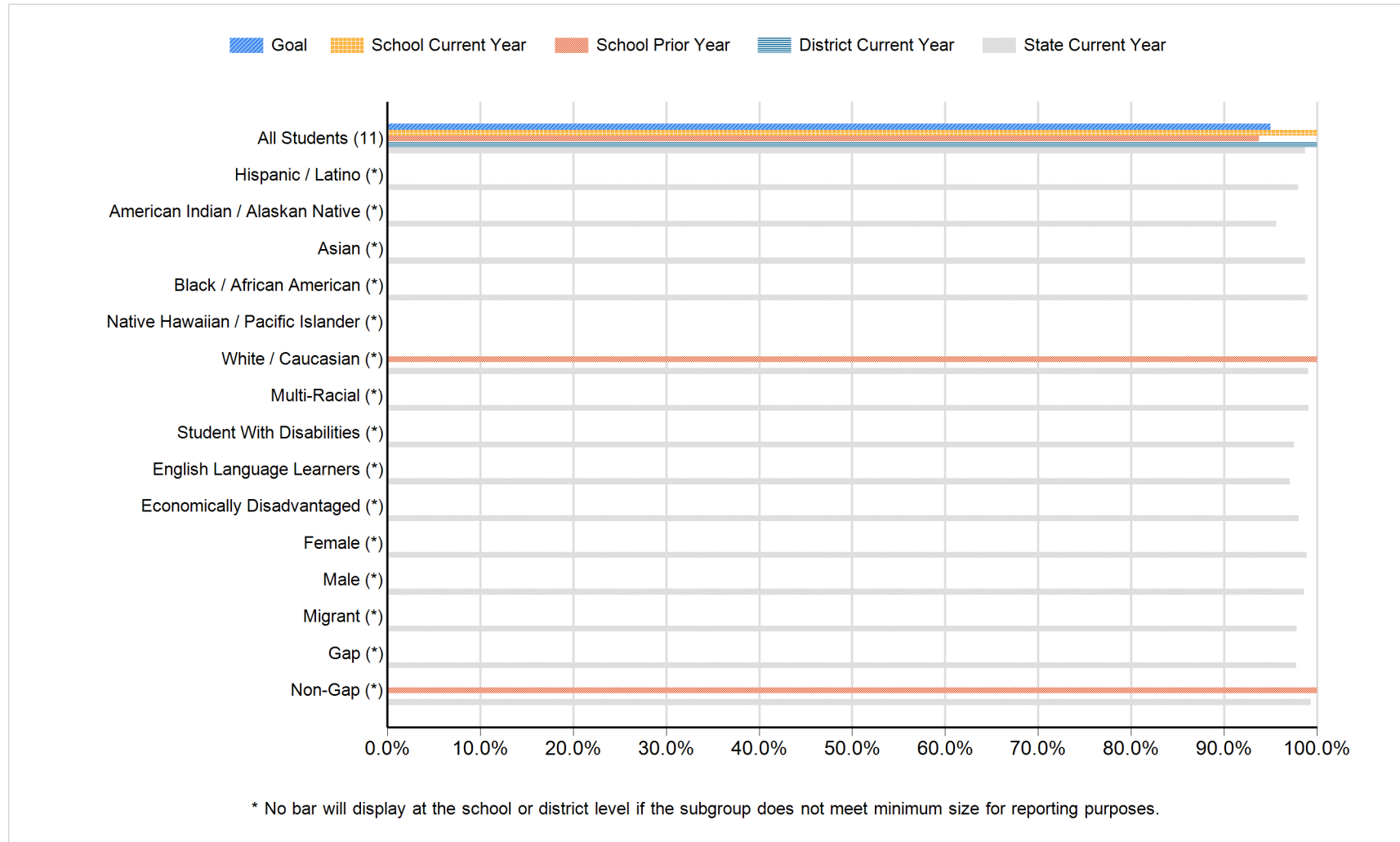

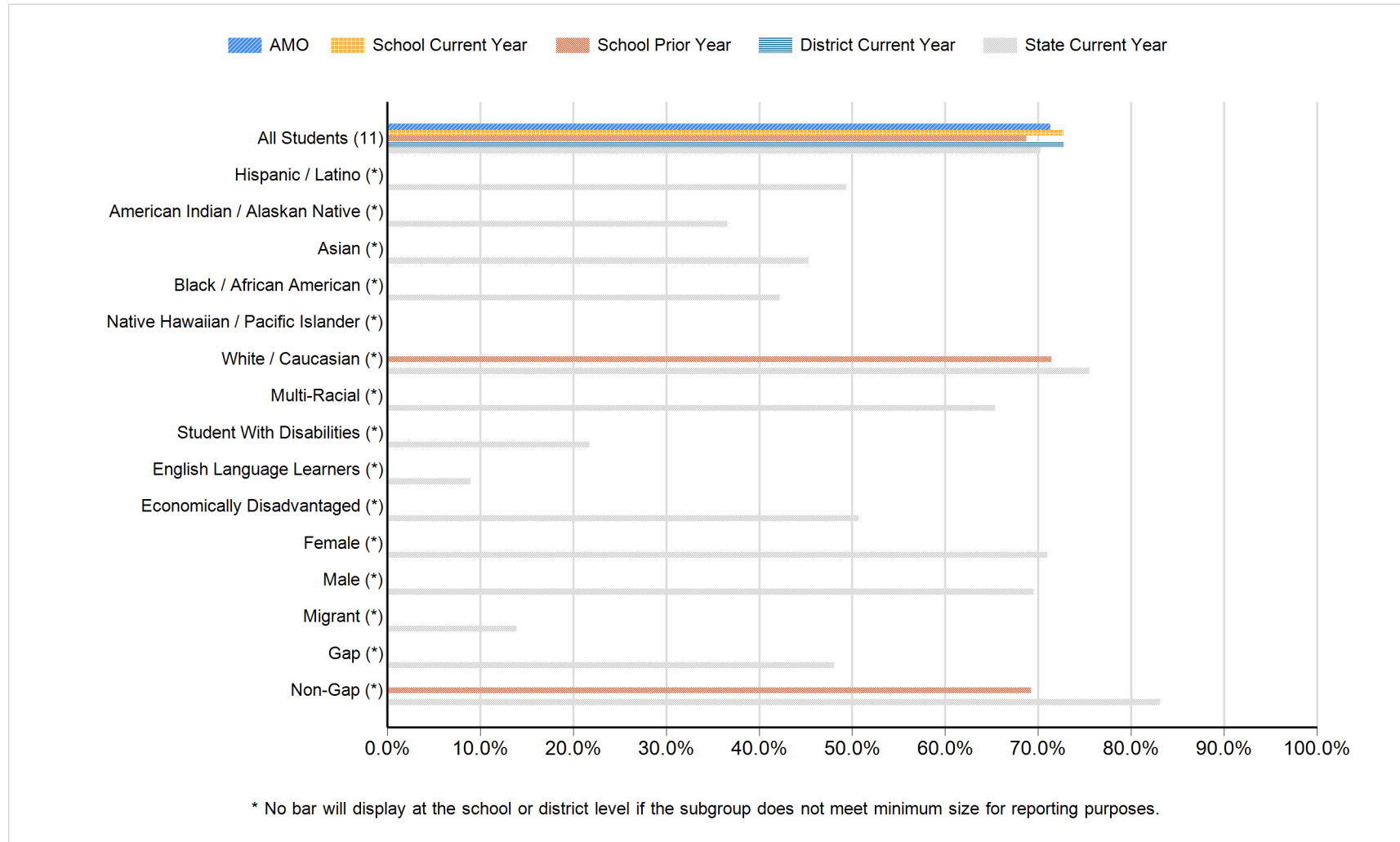

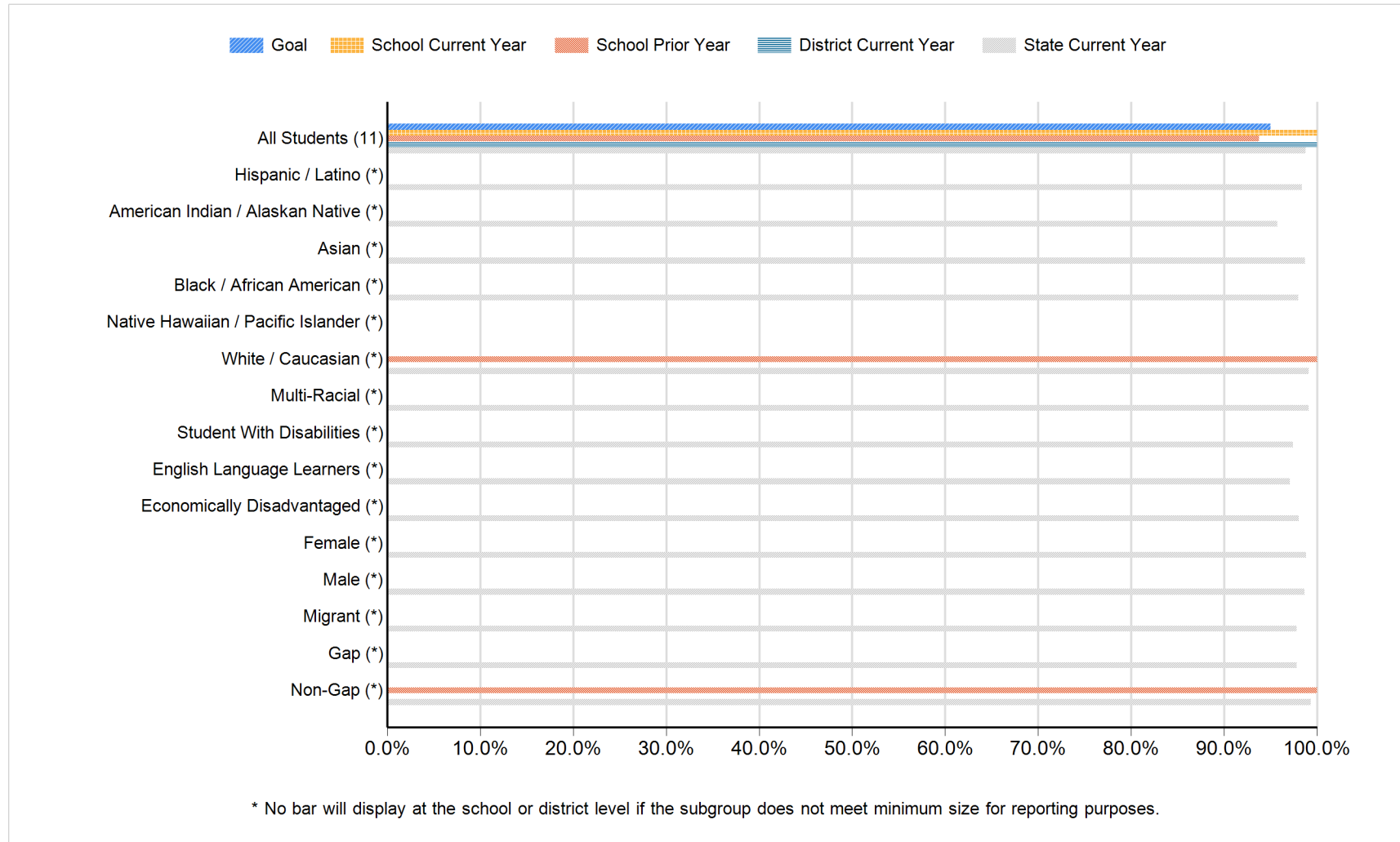

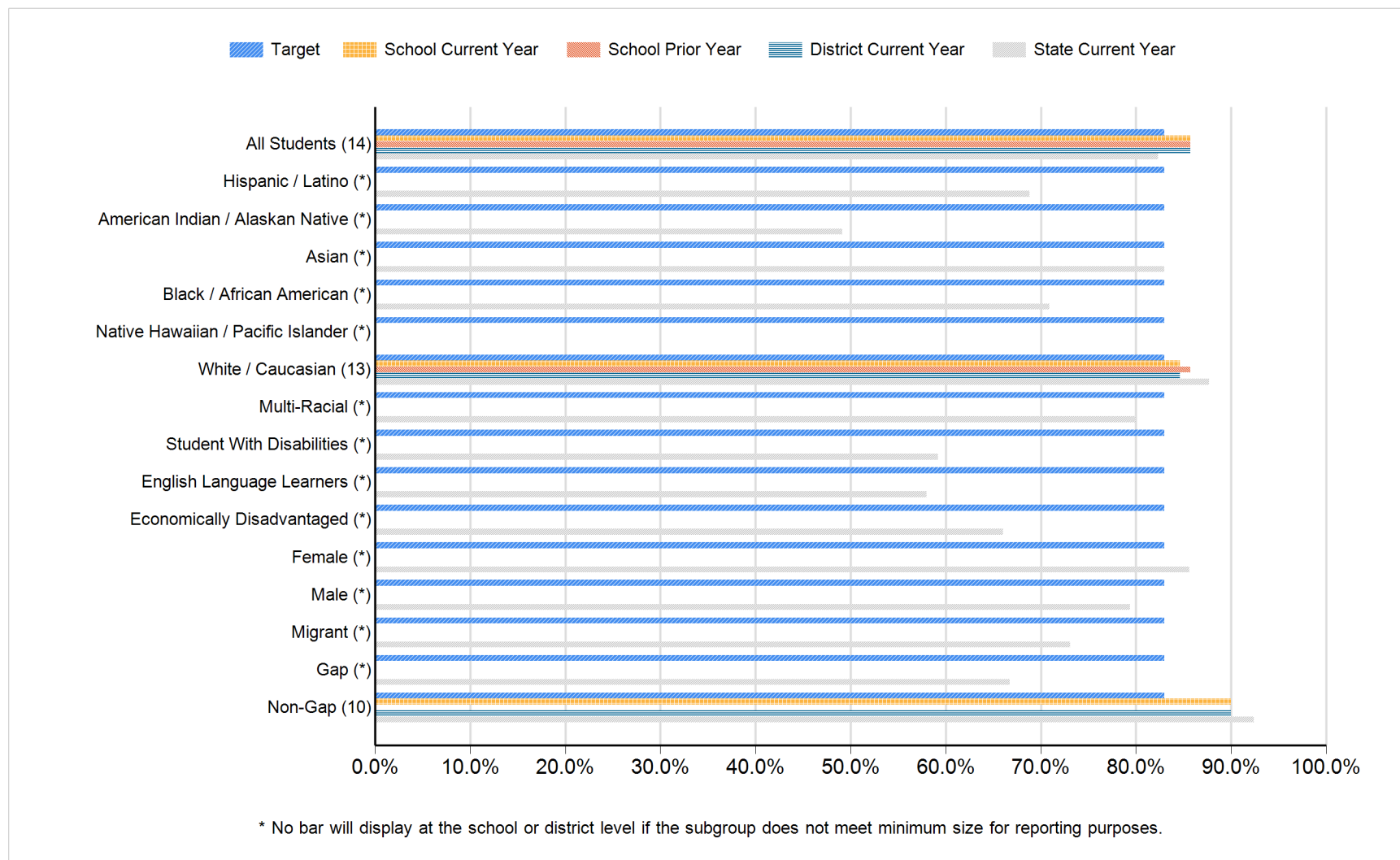

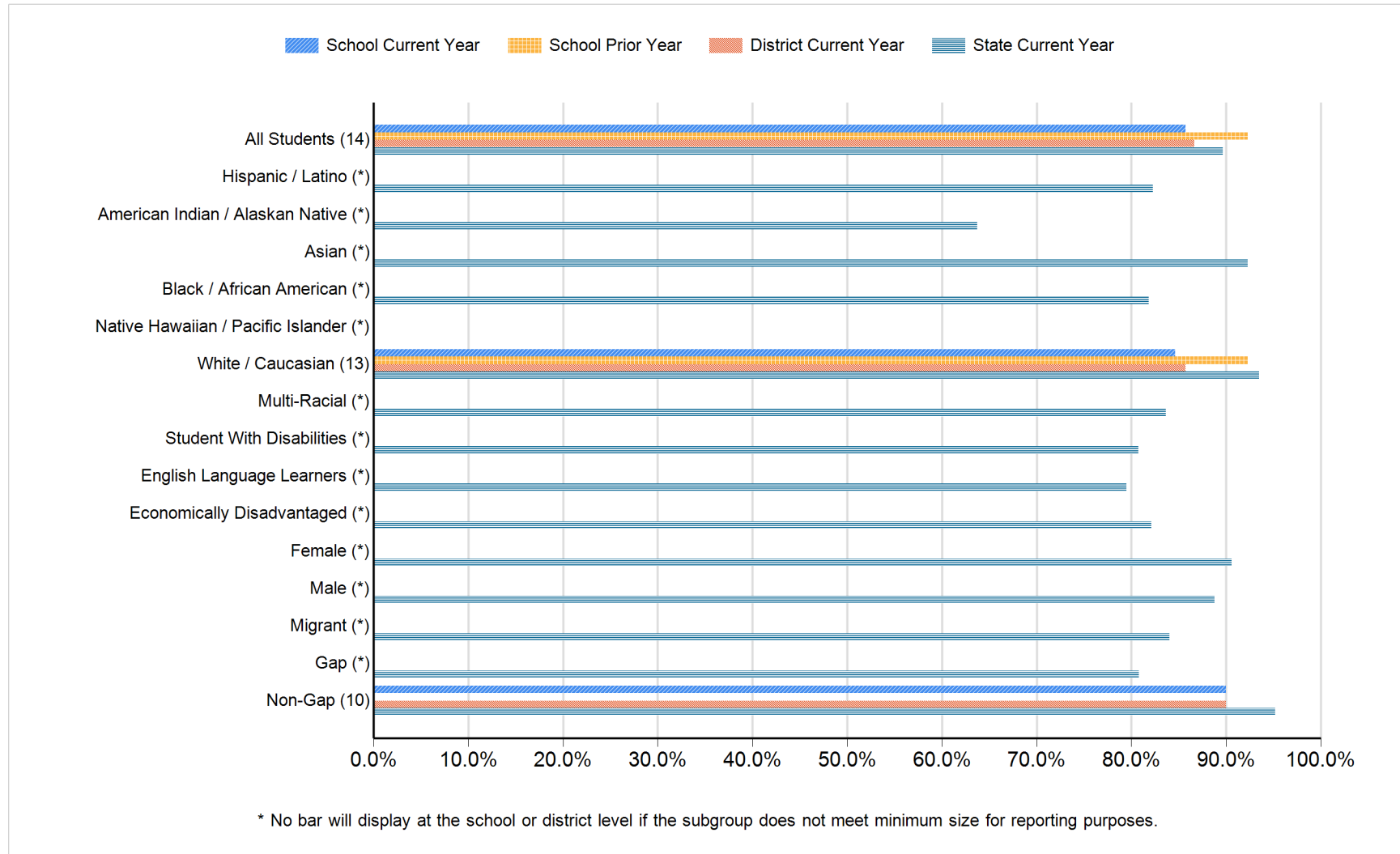

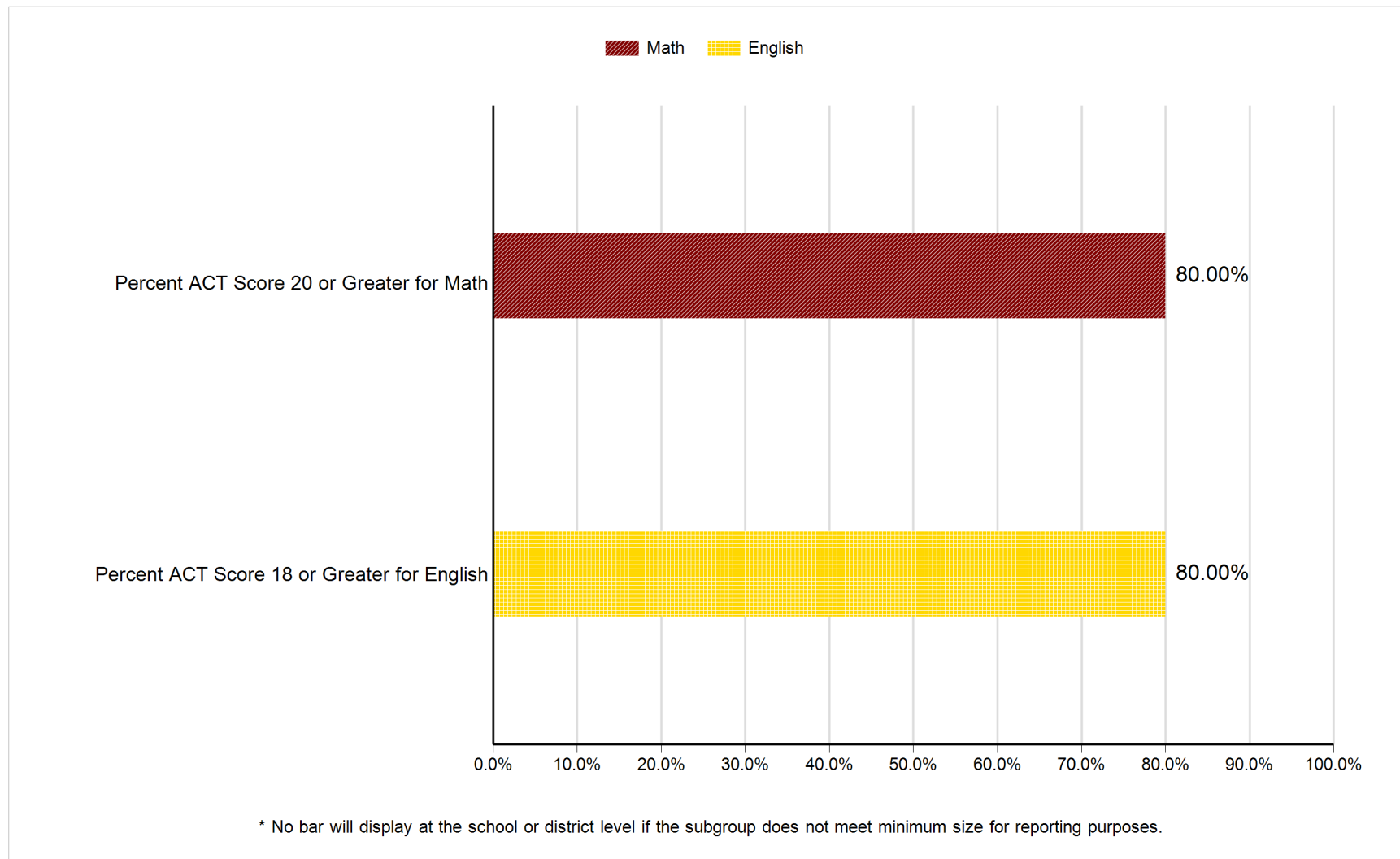
