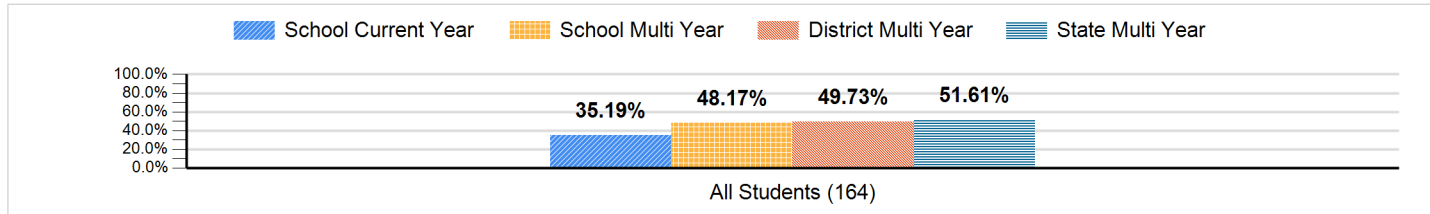
Student Population

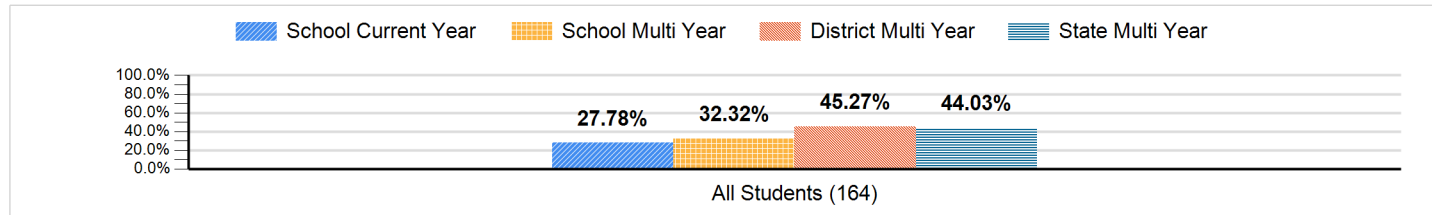

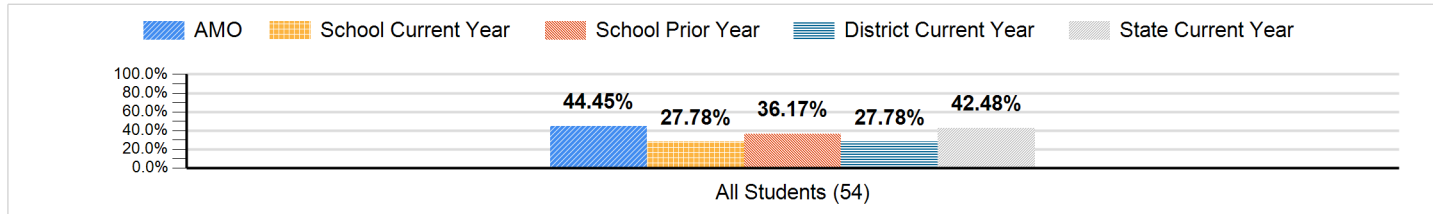

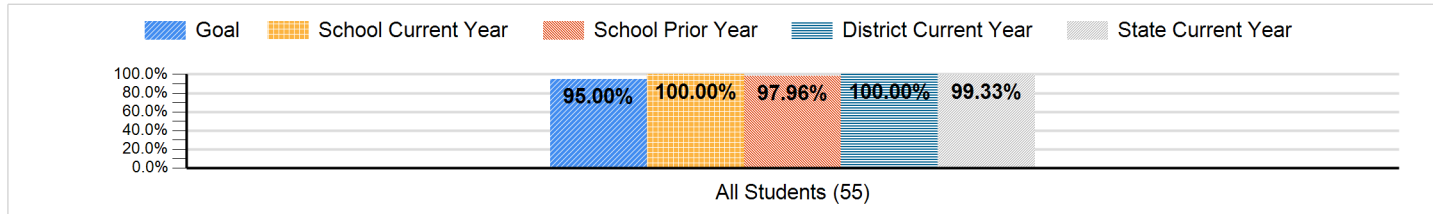

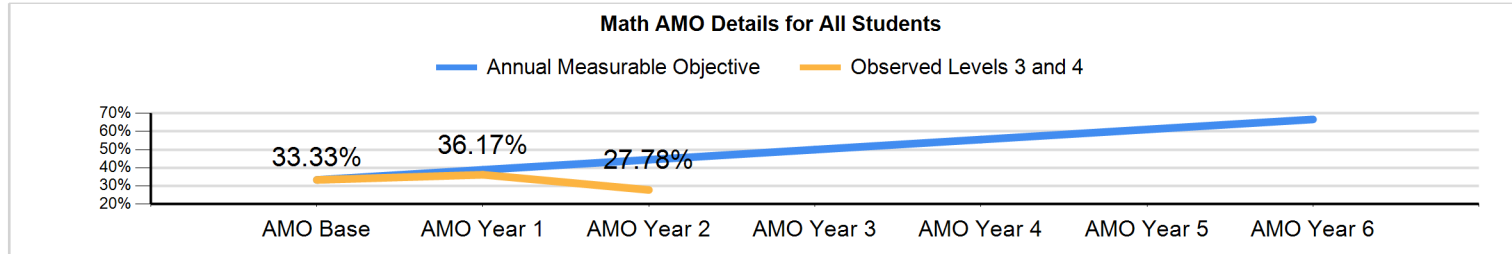

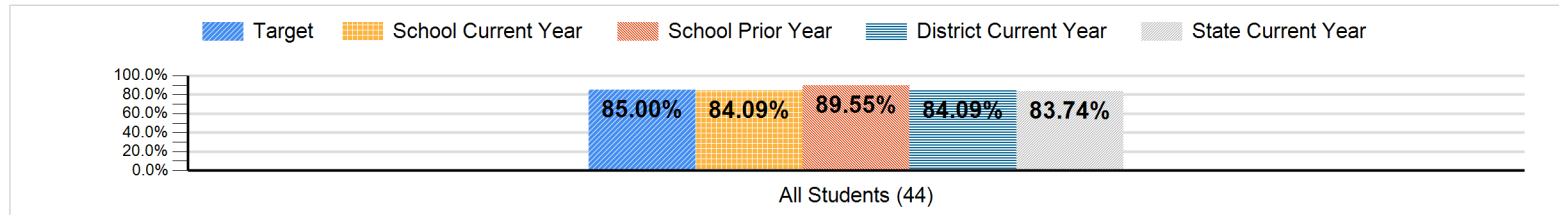

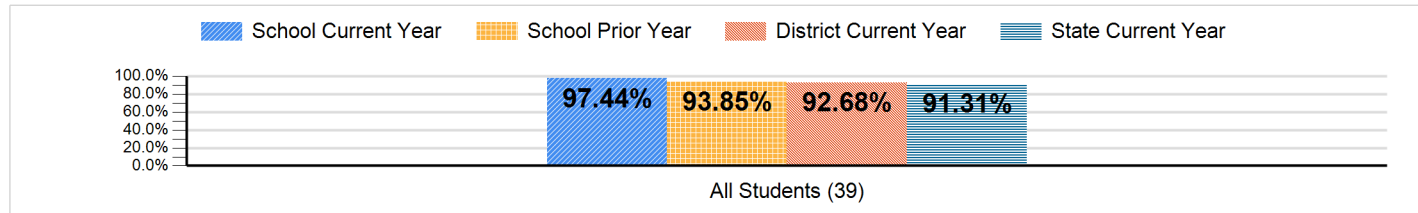
