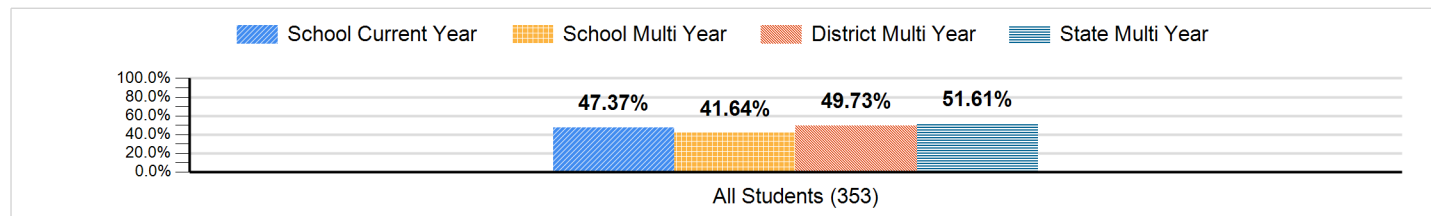
Student Population

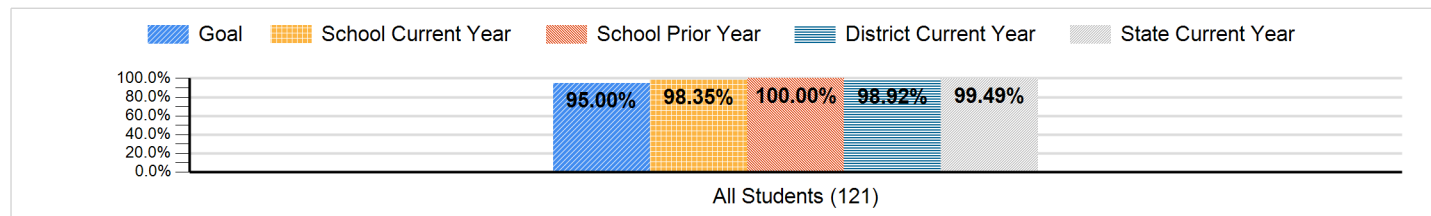

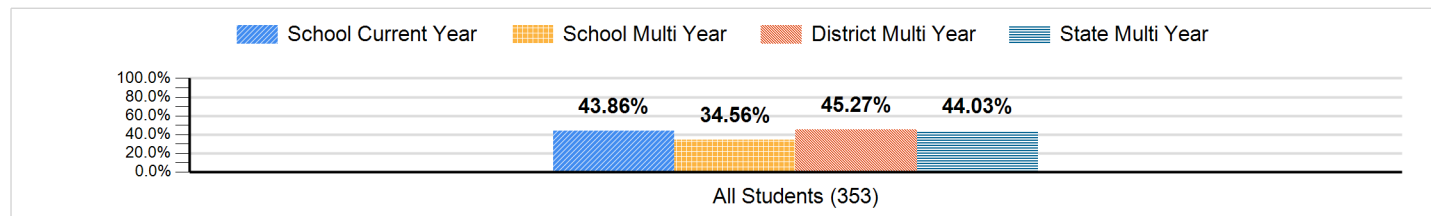

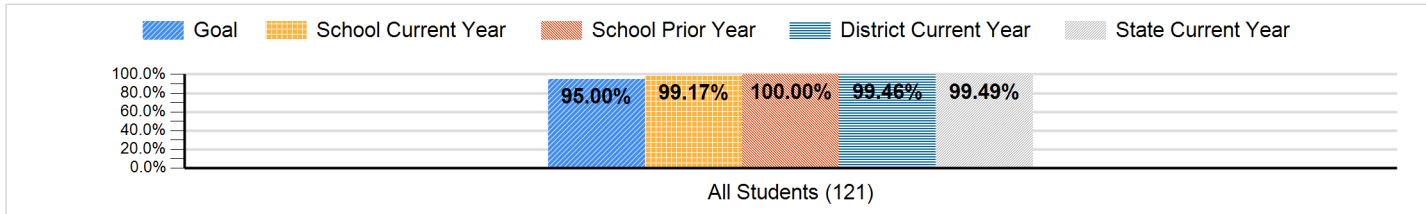

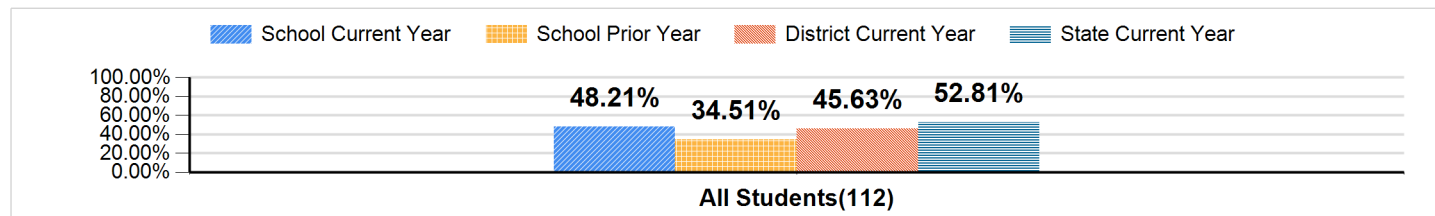

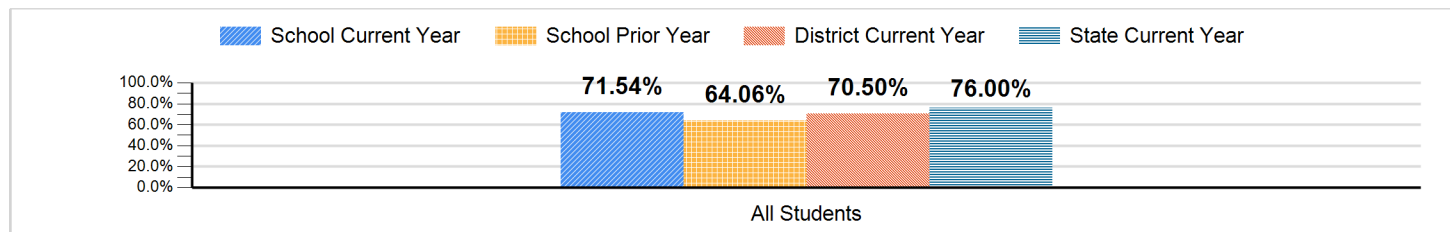
