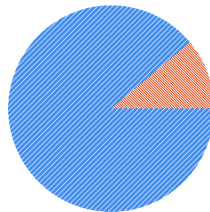

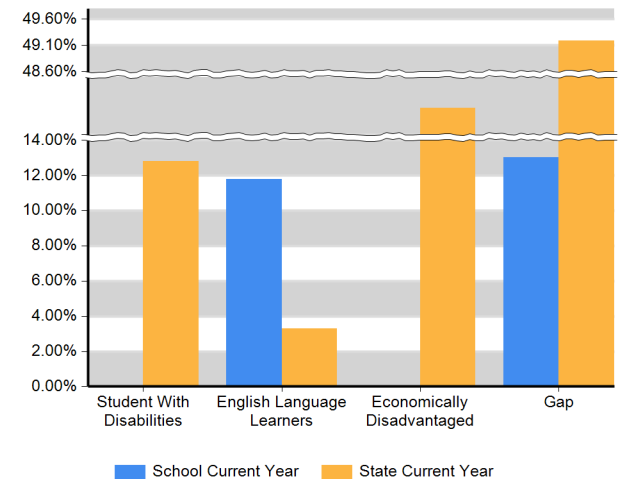

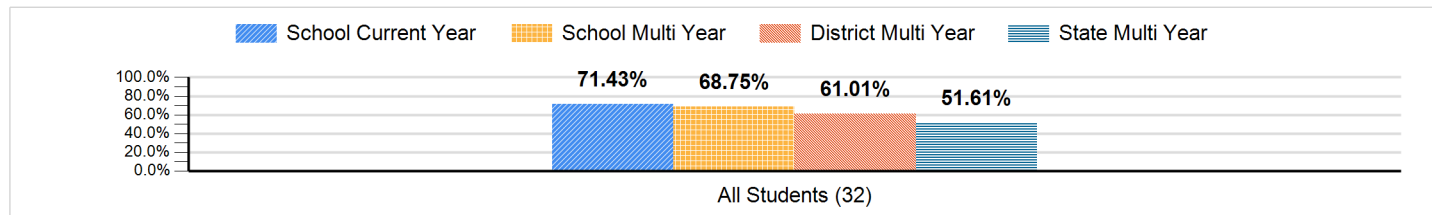
Student Population

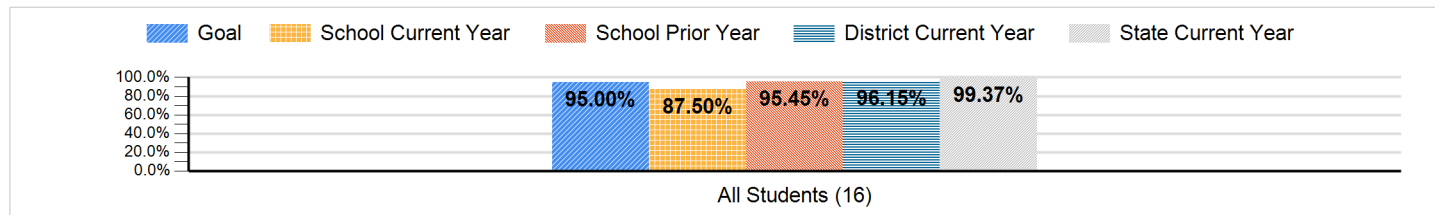

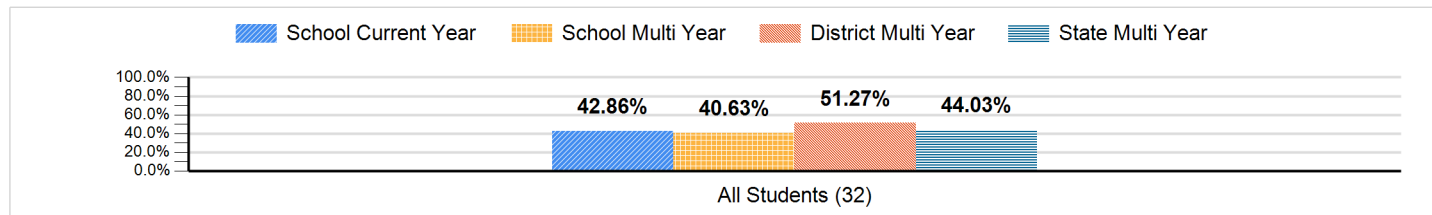

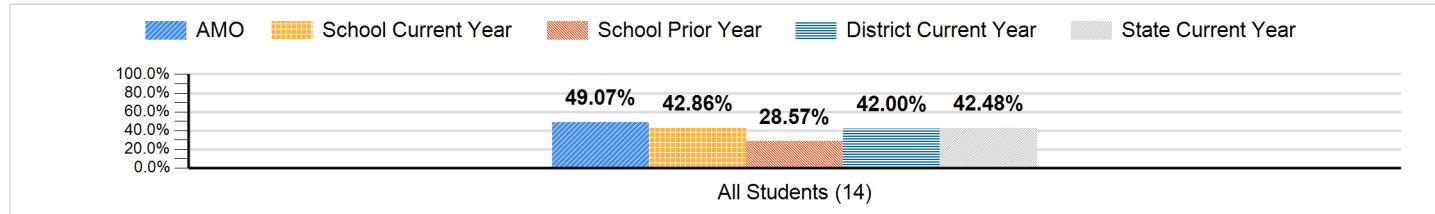

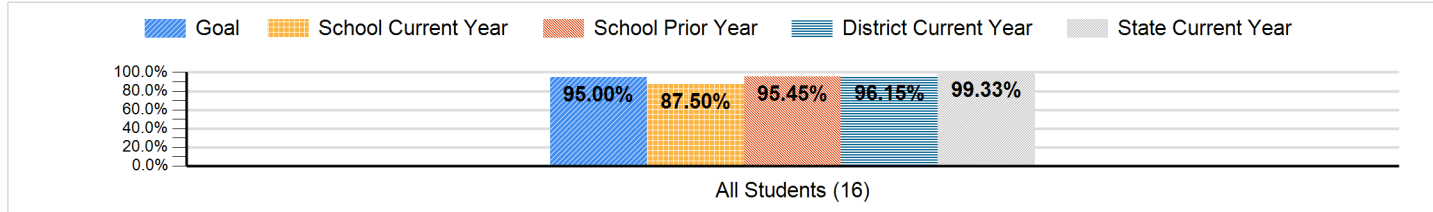

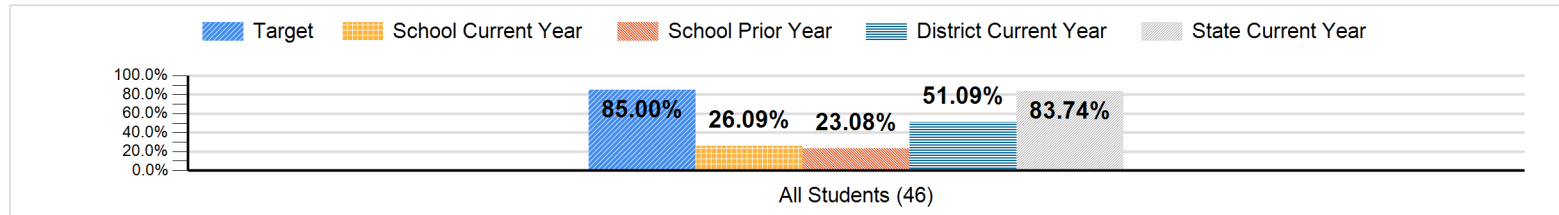

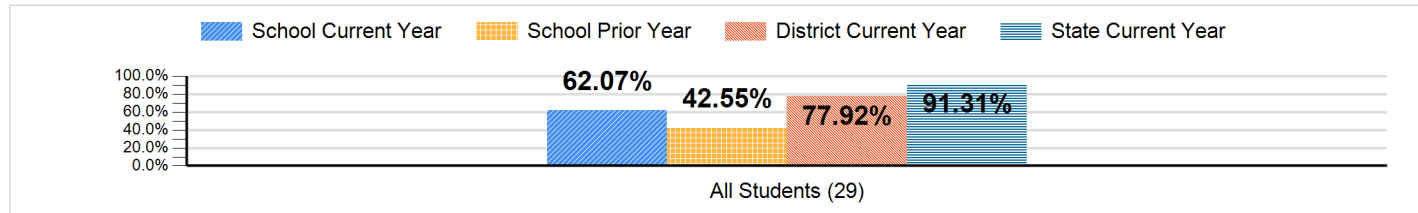
