

Join the 2022-23 National Board Certification Cohort

The 2022-23 National Board Certification (NBC) cohort will begin in October. This program provides support and guidance to teachers throughout the NBC process and pairs them with a mentor. Teachers who pursue and successfully earn National Board Certification can get graduate credits, fee reimbursement, and a \$2,000 stipend for five years. Why pursue National Board Certification?

- Students learn more from National Board-Certified Teachers (NBCT)
- Teachers improve their practice
- Schools with NBCTs have better teacher morale and retention and increased community involvement

Financial Benefits

- First time candidates can earn up to five graduate credits for submitting components and four grad credits for getting a score of 1.75 or higher.
- Fee reimbursement
- \$2,000 stipend for five years: \$1,000 paid by the Department of Education and \$1,000 paid by the school district is paid annually for up to five years. If school districts continue the stipend for another five years, the department will match.
