This message was sent to assessment coordinators and WIDA contacts in public school districts and several approved programs and non-public school systems.

SD-ELP (ACCESS Updates)

- DRC: Apple iPad Technology Updates | Action Required. Apple recently updated iPad technology which has the potential to impact online testing for ACCESS. DRC released version 15.2 of the secure application for iPads. The update will be required and must be installed on iPad devices before testing. Details for updating the secure application on iPad devices can be found in the DRC INSIGHT Technology User Guide located in WIDA AMS under My Applications | General Information | Documents.
- Required Non-Disclosure Agreement. For the SD-ELP (ACCESS) Assessment, all Assessment Coordinators and Test Administrators <u>must</u> sign the SD DOE Non-Disclosure agreement before proctoring the SD-ELP (ACCESS) assessment. Form can be found here: <u>SD DOE Non-Disclosure</u>
- Test Materials. SD DOE orders all materials for the ACCESS and Alternate ACCESS assessments.
 - SD-ELP (Access) Assessment materials have been ordered for all identified EL students in Infinite Campus as of Nov. 27, 2024.
 These materials will arrive in district between January 8-10, 2025.
 - If additional materials are needed, these orders are placed by Title III office. Please make sure that you do not have an overage of materials before you request more. Please follow the <u>Additional Orders Process</u> found under Forms.
- New English Learners Identified after November 27, 2024
 - Students identified as English Learners after November 27, 2024 will need to be added to DRC/AMS by Title III office. Please follow the <u>New Student Upload Process</u> found under Forms.
