Grades 3-8 Testing Window Opens on Monday

- SD ELA and Math Assessments – Grades 3-8
- SD Science Assessments – Grades 5 & 8
- SD Science-Alternate Assessments – Grades 5, 8, 11

SD-ACT Updates (for public-school districts only)

Help set the Cut Scores for the SD-ACT!

This week's SD-ACT Q&A

1. Do you close the test between sessions (if you do a morning session and then an afternoon session after lunch)?

- No, do not close the session. The Room Supervisor locks the records in TCM (they do not close the room and do not mark students complete)
2. Is it an irregularity if the students start after 9 (have computer issues that push the start time back)?
 - The student MUST start by 10:30. Yes, it will be an irregularity, but it won't affect testing or the scores.
 3. To clarify, do verbal instructions start at 9 or is that when students start testing?
 - Verbal instructions may begin as soon as all students have been identified and seated. It is recommended that the verbal instructions start no later than 9 a.m. in all rooms to ensure adequate testing time. Start time may be adjusted for accommodations and/or supports administrations as needed.
 4. "Error code 3018: Connection to server has been lost" showed up for a bunch of students and it kicked them out of the test. They got through, but they wondered if other districts experienced this and what they did.
 - Hopefully the district reached out to ACT Support. The district will need to fill out an irregularity for this.
 5. Will the Writing be part of the composite or separate?
 - Separate
 6. How to get out of the apps on student devices that may disrupt testing.
 - CTRL-Alt-Delete and end processes for anything that is making it so TestNav doesn't work
 - Check out the [tech guide](#). Page 4 has additional information for the question on apps on the student's device.
 7. Students with an accommodation have to be in a separate room?
 - Yes, if they have different timing or breaks as needed

Makeup Tests

In South Dakota, if a student gets sick during testing, or there is a technical glitch that is beyond their control, we WILL allow the student to make up the tests. However, if the student is dismissed because of prohibitive behavior (e.g. has a cell phone), the student will NOT be able to make up the tests.

What if a Student is Absent Day 2 (For those using the ACT Schedule Flexibility Policy)?

You will need to unassign the student and move them to a new room for the makeup date, as long as it is in the same window. Please call customer support if you need help with that after the first day of testing.

Extended Break

If your students are testing over one day and utilizing the Extended Break, **please make sure students do NOT access a cell phone during this break.** It is not allowed.

Students Showing as Not Tested

If you have students who tested, but their status shows as "not tested," the student is complete, but did not submit. If students do not submit, it takes a few days for the status to be marked "tested" after the window closes, not after they took the test. The system will mark them complete the Monday after the test window ends. Districts can see the students as tested around 48 hours after that. **Districts can always check the student's status in the TCM room at any time. The testing coordinator can go into the TCM room to see if they are complete. The school test coordinator has access to a closed room for 7 days and a room supervisor would have access for 3 days.**

SD-ACT Student Upload

We are now updating students in ACT now daily. Please check your rosters and assign students to the correct test window, and then add them to your rooms in TCM. Assigning students to the correct test windows will ensure they get their test materials on time. FYI, you can always print the students' MyACT instructions that were not shipped due to late adds. To do this, log into ACT Now, click on the Students Tab, click Reports, and click to generate the MyACT Instructions. If you see students in your ACT Now that should not be testing (seniors, alternate assessment takers), please mark them as "Will not test" within ACT Now.
