MSAA Test Window Closes this week, April 25

- SD Math and ELA Alternate Assessments- The MSAA (Math Alternate Assessment and ELA Alternate Assessment) test window at www.msaaassessment.org closes this Friday. All students assigned to alternate assessment must have all test sessions submitted by 5:00pm CT on April 25.
- If the Early Stopping Rule (ESR) is put into place, please remember to view the first four questions and mark both ELA and Math for ESR within the student's profile.

Writing Dimensions Showing as N/A or -1

You may have noticed that for some of your students, the writing dimensions in the Reporting System is showing as N/A or -1 for ELA. This is related to students receiving embedded field-test performance tasks (EFT PT). In the Reporting system, students who completed an EFT PT will initially see their CAT scores and 'n/a' or '-1' populated for the Writing dimensions.

Students will receive dimension scores as soon as their PTs have been hand-scored. As field-test sets do not contribute to a student's overall score, the scores that are live in Reporting will not change after the PTs scores are populated.
