


Assessment News Alert- May 20, 2025

This message was sent to assessment coordinators in public school districts and several approved programs and non-public school systems.

Individual Student Reports (ISRs) can include math on one side and ELA on the other now!

Districts can go to the Student Results Generator in Cambium's Reporting System and use the following settings. This will sort the PDFs in order of student. The ISRs will download all at once and they'll see the ELA and Math results for each student next to each other. See screenshot below. Just a reminder, all results should be in the Reporting System after **May 19**.
