Download MSAA Test Results before Sept. 5

South Dakota ELA-Alternate and Math-Alternate spring 2025 results are currently available in the <u>MSAA System</u>. District Test Coordinators must download test results for students in their district **before Sept. 5, 2025 at 5 p.m. CT**. Districts are federally required to provide results of individual student state assessment performance to parents. Print and send MSAA results to parents and share with Test Administrators as soon as possible. The <u>2025 Score Report Interpretation Guide</u> and MSAA Parent Guides per grade level on the <u>Alternate Assessment</u> <u>Website</u> can also be shared with parents.
