SD-ACT

Starting in 2026, all South Dakota 11th grade students attending public high schools will take the ACT as their state assessment.

Roles & Responsibilities

Contract Coordinator: Highest level of oversight, adds district & school data, adds district & school test coordinators, import student data

District Test Coordinator: Manages all schools in their district, adds school test coordinators & test staff

Test Coordinator: Has school-level oversight, adds test staff, assigns test events to students, prepares test rooms in Test Center Manager (TCM), responsible for pre-test & post-test day checklist tasks

Test Accommodations Coordinator: Supports test coordinators, requests accommodations for the ACT through TAA, manages student accommodations

Technical Coordinator: Prepares school environment to support online testing, installs TestNav on all devices, performs technical readiness test with Test Coordinator

Test Event Staff: Includes room supervisors, proctors, and roving proctors, administers tests using Test Center Manager (TCM)
