  - If you are signed up for the day long Farm to School session on June 9 or 10, the morning field trips are a rain or shine event, so make sure you pack accordingly...just in case! I'd also suggest closed toe shoes or sandals.
- Update iCAN Applications! Has your organization had any staffing changes recently? If so, please don't
  forget to update the iCAN application. Making these updates informs our office to remove inactive staff's
  access to iCAN and helps ensure that our office communications are sent to the correct people! If any
  changes are made to the application, please don't forget to submit the application for approval so our
  office can approve the changes!
- CANS Meal Modification Form Update: CANS has updated the meal modification form to make it more
  user-friendly and consistent across all child nutrition programs. We encourage your district to consider
  using the updated form, which is designed to help ensure all meal modification requirements are met.

#### **Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) Reminders or Updates:**

 Annual Training reminder: Don't forget to complete your required annual trainings before the September 30 deadline. As a reminder, our Pathways to Child Nutrition Conference held in June will cover all topics to meet training requirements. Suggested staff to attend this training are the Authorized Representative, Food Service Director, Agency Contact, or any other main program personnel.

### **School Nutrition Program (SNP) Reminders or Updates:**

\*\*Upcoming Deadline\*\* Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). The list of eligible and near eligible sites and districts is posted on the <u>CANS SNP website</u> in the School Meal Requirements section. The percentages that make a district or site eligible decreased last year. Sites that have an Identified Student Percentage (ISP) of 25% or greater are eligible for CEP. Sites that have an Identified Student Percentage (ISP) between 15% - 24.99% are potentially eligible. If you are eligible and would like to apply, submit the <u>CEP Application</u> by May 31, 2025.

- \*\*Upcoming Deadline\*\* SSO iCAN Applications: As a reminder, SSO applications must be fully approved by May 20, 2025. Please submit your SSO application as soon as possible! It can take a week or so for the application to be fully approved, so it must be submitted before the May 16 deadline to be approved in time.
- Summer School and Extending the NSLP/SBP School Year: If you are planning to have summer school and would like to continue feeding (only) the kids that are enrolled in summer school, please let us know, and we will help you make the necessary iCAN SNP application updates.
- School Year 2025-2026 iCAN Applications Open in iCAN. The deadline for SNP iCAN application approval is August 15, 2025. We are providing open hours through Zoom to answer questions and provide one on one assistance with your application. No reservation is needed, you can join during any open hours times to get instant help from CANS staff.

\*\*Upcoming Deadline\*\*Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program iCAN Application. The SY 2025-26 Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program iCAN application is now available in the iCAN system for current participants and schools that have requested an application. The iCAN SNP Application Agency Manual is on the <u>CANS SNP webpage</u> under Application and Claim Information. We recommend that you follow the manual when filling out your application to ensure you are following the proper sequence to avoid extra or lost work. The manual is a useful tool in answering questions you may have about the application or how to answer some of the questions.

**Checklist items:** The Paid Lunch Equity (PLE) Tool has not been released, so the PLE and Annual Information Update checklist items are not yet uploaded into iCAN. Also, be sure to complete the 2025–2026 forms located in the Checklist Summary Items and Download sections of your iCAN application. Some forms have been updated, and it's important that we have the most current information about your program operations.

- SFSP: iCAN applications are open! Be aware that all applications must be approved by May 19. If your application is not approved by that date, you will not be able to operate SFSP this year.
