#### **All Program Reminders or Updates:**

- Update iCAN Applications: Has your organization had any staffing changes recently? If so, please don't
  forget to update the iCAN application! Making these updates informs our office to remove inactive staff's
  access to iCAN and helps ensure that our office communications are sent to the correct people! If any
  changes are made to the application, please don't forget to submit the application for approval so our
  office can approve the changes!
- **iMATCH User Updates:** Along with iCAN applications, the iMATCH system also needs to be updated as staff changes. Please remember to contact CANS when changes occur and request an iMATCH form to add/remove users to keep records up to date.
- DOE Professional <u>Learning Platform</u>: We have changed the way that the trainings within the system are
  organized for ease of use for sponsors to choose the appropriate trainings for them. From the Categories
  drop down select <u>Child and Adult Nutrition Services</u>, enroll in your Program (ex. All SNP trainings are listed
  under the School Nutrition Programs). See the information at the bottom of the minutes for additional
  information.
- Revised Food Buying Guide: The Food Buying Guide for Child Nutrition Programs (FBG) has been revised to reflect the final rule, "Child Nutrition Programs: Meal Patterns Consistent With the 2020–2025 Dietary Guidelines for Americans". This important resource assists CNP operators with purchasing the correct amounts of foods and determining the contribution that each food makes toward meal pattern requirements. The FBG is available as a Web Tool, Mobile App, and downloadable PDF.
- Claim Due Dates: 10th of the following month & 60 days final deadline:
  - Claims are due in the iCAN system on the 10th of the month (e.g. August claim is due by September 10).
  - o For all programs: SNP, SFSP, CACFP, including Sponsors of DCH
  - A final claim for reimbursement shall be submitted no later than 60 days following the last day of the full month covered by the claim. (e.g. August claim final claim date would be October 30)

- Equipment Purchase Preapproval Reminder: This reminder applies to all programs SNP, CACFP, and SFSP.
   Preapproval is required for equipment (includes computer systems) purchased with nutrition funds, when:
  - the equipment is not listed on the preapproved equipment list found in <u>CANS memo 241-2</u>, or

 the equipment is listed on the preapproved equipment list and the cost of that equipment is more than the capitalization threshold (Federal Capitalization threshold is \$10,000, some schools may have a lower threshold).

Check what your agency's capitalization threshold and use this form for preapproval requests: <u>CNP</u> Equipment Purchase Preapproval Request Form

#### **Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) Reminders or Updates:**

- New Requirement for Sponsoring Organizations:
  - The integrity final regulation requires CANS to verify one month of CACFP sponsoring organization's bank account activity with supporting documents to verify that the financial transactions meet program requirements, including but not limited to proper use of federal funds and cost allowability.
  - These reviews will begin this program year (2024-25). We are finalizing our procedures and will share more information soon.
  - This requirement does not apply to independent centers or school food authorities operating CACFP and NSLP.
- The new Program year has started! As a reminder, you must complete the annual CACFP training during the program year (October 1- September 30). CANS will be hosting an in-person training this summer! Be on the lookout for more information!
- **PY 2024-2025 Applications are due Monday, October 7**. Please complete your iCAN application as soon as possible. If you have questions or need assistance, please contact us!

### **School Nutrition Program (SNP) Reminders or Updates:**

- Verification: Verification activities are underway and include all of your Free and Reduced applications on file as of October 1<sup>st</sup>. The Verification Process webinar can be viewed by going to <a href="https://sded.sd.gov/">https://sded.sd.gov/</a>. From the Categories drop down select Child and Adult Nutrition Services, enroll in School Nutrition Programs, and find Verification Process Training.
- National School Lunch Week is Oct. 14-28, 2024: "School Lunch Pirates: Find Your Treasure" is the theme for National School Lunch Week this year. This annual event was established by President Kennedy in 1962 to highlight the benefits of the National School Lunch Program. Schools across the country mark the week with special menus, fun events, and activities that emphasize the positive impact of healthy school meals on students' lives. Revised Whole Grain Resource: The final rule requires that at least 80 percent of the weekly grains
offered in school lunch and breakfast programs be whole grain-rich, with USDA defining "whole grainrich" as products containing 50 to 100 percent whole grains, with any remaining grains being enriched.
The Whole Grain Resource provides clear guidance to help users determine whether grain products meet
these standards.

- Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program:
  - FFVP iCAN claim error is corrected. If you did not get your August claim submitted due to this
    error, it will be processed with September claims. The final day to submit an August claim is
    October 30.
  - o **First Allocation ended** on September 30. All funds from the first allocation should be utilized by that time. Funds from the first award <u>cannot</u> be carried over to the second award. The second award funding can be used starting October 1 through the end of SY 2024-25. Reach out to <u>Diana Webb</u> or <u>Diana Leiseth</u> with questions.
- Administrative and Procurement Reviews: Schools scheduled to receive an administrative review in SY24-25 should have received an email notification. Some reviews will be conducted by CANS staff, and some will be conducted by CNR. If CNR is doing your review a representative will be contacting you via email to begin the review process. We work very closely with them so feel free to reach out to us with any questions or concerns as you go through your review with them. We are working on the new 5-year cycle and that will be posted to the website in the coming months.
- **Civil Rights Training Reminder:** All staff that work directly with the School Nutrition Programs and their direct supervisors are required to attend Civil Rights training annually. You can find a link to the <u>CANS Civil Rights training</u> on the <u>CANS webpage</u> under the Civil Rights heading.
- Afterschool Snack Onsite Monitoring: As a reminder, districts that operate the after-school snack
  program in addition to the NSLP and SBP must complete a monitoring review within their first four weeks
  of operation. You can find the dates that your district planned to conduct your monitoring visits in your
  SNP iCAN application in the Verification and Monitoring Checklist Item. Monitoring forms are found on

## **USDA Foods in School/Food Distribution Program Reminders or Updates:**

- Please check your USDA Food Deliveries as everyone makes mistakes including the drivers and warehouse employees. If your USDA Foods order is missing product, has damaged product, or has extra items, an OS&D report needs to be completed in the Food Distribution Program in iCAN within 5 days of your USDA Foods delivery. The OS&D report in iCAN shows the agency's full delivery because the iCAN system does not know what was shorted. Do not put shortages in the damaged column unless the product is damaged and it is given back to the driver. If one can is damaged, do not report the whole case as damaged. Take the numbers out of the units received column and place the correct amount received in the units received column. OS&D reports need to be completed in the Food Distribution Program in iCAN within 7 days of your USDA Foods delivery. - Remember to receipt your DoD Fresh/FFAVORS orders in the FFAVORS system within 7 days of your DoD
  Fresh/FFAVORS delivery. If you do not receipt your order, the DLA representative will be emailing you to
  receipt your order ASAP.


