As you plan your library's summer reading program, the South Dakota State Library Children and Youth Services and the South Dakota Department of Education Child and Adult Nutrition Services want to make you aware of the Summer Food Service Program. As part of this program, organizations across South Dakota serve free meals to the state's youth during the summer months. Children age 18 and younger may receive a meal free of charge at participating sites, which include organizations such as nonprofits, schools, libraries and local governments.

By texting "Food" to 877-877 or "Summer Meals" to 97779; calling 1-866-3-HUNGRY (1-866-348-6479), or visiting www.fns.usda.gov/summerfoodrocks throughout the summer, families will have access to the most current information on free feeding locations, menus, time of meal service and days and dates of operation.

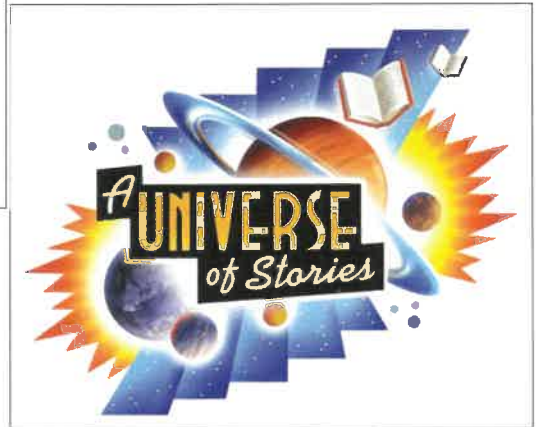
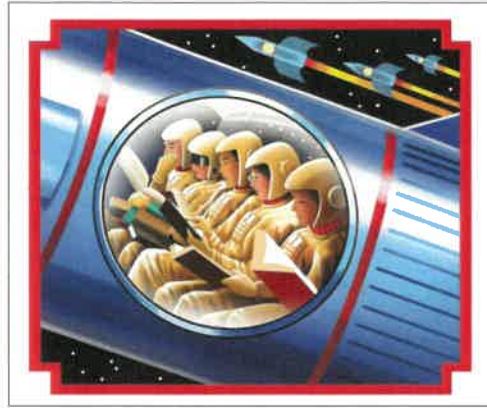
