Name of Certificate	Certificate will be referred to as an Alternative Preliminary Certificate.
Certificate Type	Alternative Preliminary Certificate - A type of certificate for individuals who choose to go through the Alternative Certification Route in order to obtain an Educator Certificate.
Authorization	An Alternative Preliminary Certificate does <b>NOT</b> allow you to teach but does allow you to be hired by a school district. Once hired you will then need to apply for the next step in the process.
Persons Required to hold an Alternative Preliminary Certificate	<ul> <li>Prior to applying for one of the following Alternative Certificates, an applicant must receive an Alternative Preliminary Certificate:</li> <li>General education alternative certificate;</li> <li>Career and technical education (CTE) alternative certificate;</li> <li>Teach for America (TFA) alternative certificate; or</li> <li>Administrator alternative certificate.</li> </ul>
Duration and Expiration of Certificate	<ul><li>Two-year Certificate</li><li>Certificates expire June 30th</li></ul>
Fees	<ul> <li>\$20 Initial Alternative Preliminary Certificate</li> <li>\$20 2-year Renewal</li> </ul>
Requirements	<ul> <li>Bachelor's degree or higher from a regionally-accredited institution of higher education;</li> <li>Associate of applied science (A.AS.) degree or higher in a CTE field;</li> <li>4,000 documented hours of work experience in a CTE field; or</li> <li>Hold a national certification in a related CTE field.</li> </ul>
Review of Application	Within ten business days of receipt of a <u>complete</u> application, a determination of whether the applicant meets the requirements for issuance of the Alternative Preliminary certificate will be made by the department.
Renewal Requirements	<ul> <li>One hour of Suicide Awareness and Prevention Training is required by state statute.</li> </ul>
