

## ***Native American Lakota, Dakota, Nakota Language and Culture Permit***

<b>Description</b>	Allows individuals without a teaching degree to teach the Lakota language and culture. Applicants must demonstrate knowledge of the language and culture.
<b>Duration of certificate</b>	5 years
<b>Cost</b>	\$25
<b>Applicant eligibility requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Completion of an approved suicide awareness and prevention training</li> <li>• 3-hour methodology course directly related to teaching Lakota, Dakota, Nakota language and culture</li> <li>• Demonstrates proficiency in Lakota, Dakota, or Nakota oral and written language and culture and recommended for licensure by a regionally-accredited institution of higher education offering a teacher education program in Lakota Studies</li> <li>• Recommended for licensure to teach Lakota, Dakota, or Nakota oral and written language and culture by an indigenous language board or similar organization recognized by tribal government</li> </ul>
