

Reciprocity Requirements	
ARSD 24:28:16	Eligibility for Reciprocity Based on Completion of Approved Educator Program
Eligibility Requirements	<ul> <li>Received a teacher, administrator, or educator specialist certificate in another state.</li> <li>Must complete full state-certification. May not be a temporary, emergency, substitute, or provisional certificate.</li> <li>Completed a successful student teaching, internship, or field experience.</li> <li>Provide verification from the licensing state that there are no disciplinary actions or ethics violations.</li> </ul>
Requirements	<ul> <li>Complete an approved <u>suicide awareness and prevention training</u>.</li> <li>Pass approved 3-credit <u>South Dakota Indian studies course</u> with a C or higher.</li> </ul>
Provisional Certificate	• Applicant may receive a one-year provisional certificate to complete South Dakota Indian Studies. This certificate may be renewed once.
Adding Endorsement to a VALID Out-of-State Educator Certificate	<ul> <li>Preparations and endorsements may be added based on a review of the out-of-state certificate and the equivalent South Dakota preparations and endorsements. Unless otherwise stipulated, no additional content or pedagogy requirements apply.</li> <li>If the applicant has a categorical special education endorsement, the applicant must pass the state-designated content test for a K-12 special education endorsement.</li> <li>If the applicant has a K-8 special education endorsement, the applicant must nave a minimum of one year of teaching experience as a secondary teacher or pass the state-designated pedagogy test for the secondary level to add the K-12 special education endorsement.</li> </ul>
Adding Endorsements to an Inactive, Expired, or Invalid Out- of-State Educator Certificate	<ul> <li>Endorsements may be added if the applicant has:</li> <li>A major in content;</li> <li>Active National Board Certification in the content area; or</li> <li>Meets the South Dakota endorsement requirements</li> </ul>
Requirements to Add New Endorsements	• If the applicant is seeking additional endorsements not included on the out- of-state certificate, the applicant must meet South Dakota requirements to add the endorsement.
