Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allows a student teacher holding this permit to receive monetary compensation from a school partner. • Allows a student teacher holding this permit to be hired as a teacher of record.
Duration of Certificate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One year, non-renewable
Applicant Eligibility Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Official transcript confirming satisfactory completion of educational coursework likely to be met by the start date of the student teaching experience and registration of final coursework • Successfully completed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ state-designated pedagogy test ○ state-designated content test(s) ○ 60 minutes of approved suicide awareness and prevention training • Obtained sign-off from the educator preparation program • Participate in a mentor program • Adhere to the South Dakota Code of Professional Ethics for Teachers

District Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IF hiring as a teacher of record: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Verify applicant holds a valid advanced student teacher permit ○ Document that the school attempted but was unable to hire a teacher with a professional or advanced teaching certificate ○ Submit Intent to Employ Form prior to student teaching to allow time for approval ○ Provide board minutes indicating the approval to hire a student teacher with the advanced student teacher permit to serve as the teacher of record ○ Provide an assigned cooperating teacher for support (i.e. academic and classroom management) of the student teacher, but who will not provide direct guidance and supervision as under the traditional student teaching experience ○ Provide assurances of regular observations, guidance, and evaluation of assigned duties by principal ○ Expected/required to provide monetary compensation if this individual is serving as a teacher of record ○ Offer enrollment in a mentoring program ○ Provide information on the South Dakota Code of Professional Ethics for Teachers

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If the student teacher is serving as a teacher of record, report the approved student teacher in the PRF
Endorsements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Awarded to individual qualified to student teach in their content area(s) of study (as indicated through their educator preparation program)
Renewal Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certificate type is non-renewable • Next step is to transition to a Professional Teaching Certificate
