## A school district or department-accredited school employing a TFA alternative teaching certificate applicant shall: • Verify the applicant has a valid alternative preliminary certificate; o Document the school attempted but was unable to hire a certified teacher prior to hiring an applicant with an alternative certificate; **Employer Requirements** Offer a mentoring program; o Provide the applicant with information about the SD Code of Professional Ethics for Teachers; o Train the applicant on the school teacher evaluation system; and Recommend the alternative certification teacher for renewal based on documented performance and progress. • A TFA alternative certificate holder applying for a professional teaching certificate shall: o Complete a minimum of 15 transcripted credits with a C or higher in the following: Classroom management; Teaching methods; Requirements to Obtain Student assessment; a Professional Teaching Differentiated instruction; **Certificate** Adolescent psychology; and South Dakota Indian studies. Pass the state-designated pedagogy test; o Adhere to the SD Code of Professional Ethics for Teachers; and Receive signoff from the employing school/district. o Participate in a mentor program

Maximum Length of Certificate	<ul> <li>The applicant has three years to complete the TFA alternative teaching certificate.
