


and places to further strengthen CTE programs.

Additionally, the NCRC assists students in demonstrating career readiness by matching their skill level to thousands of occupations using the Job Profiles Database. Learn more about the NCRC.

The SD-STARS team will provide trainings soon for distric users of SD-STARS. Morning and afternoon sessions will be offered in three loations throughout the state.

- AM: In the morning sessions, SAMs will discover who has SD-STARS accounts, and how to properly maintain those accounts.
- PM: District users will learn how to find and use data in SD-STARS. They will also see a history of their own district's report usage. This information will help them decide the best reports to use this year.
