Other Education Degree Program

Have a bachelor's degree or higher from a non-CTE related educator preparation program	Degree Programs may include: Math, Science, or Elementary Education, etc.
Educator would have completed an educator preparation program from a regionally accredited institution of higher education and would have received a written recommendation to obtain teacher license.	
Educator must take CTE Methods for two credits to add CTE endorsements	
Educator must pass the State Designated Pedagogy Test - the PLT 7-12 PRAXIS 5624 or PLT PK-12 PRAXIS 5625
