

16 or 17 YEAR OLDS' PATH TO EARNING THE GED® CREDENTIAL

APPROVAL

Attending School

Must meet the following:

- Parent/guardian gives their permission
- School administrator verifies student will not graduate on time because of a credit deficiency
- Authorization from a court services officer
- A court order requiring student to enter the program
- Verification a student is under the direction of DOC
- Student is enrolled in a Job Corps program

Receiving Alternative Instruction

- Parents/guardians who choose to provide alternative instruction must **FIRST** file an [Alternative Instruction Notification](#) with the South Dakota Department of Education

These requirements are established by [South Dakota Codified Law \(SDCL\) 13-27-1.4](#).

REQUIREMENTS

Attending School

- Parents/guardians, and school district staff work to create a plan for helping the student prepare for and complete the four GED® exams while still meeting all state and local enrollment requirements
