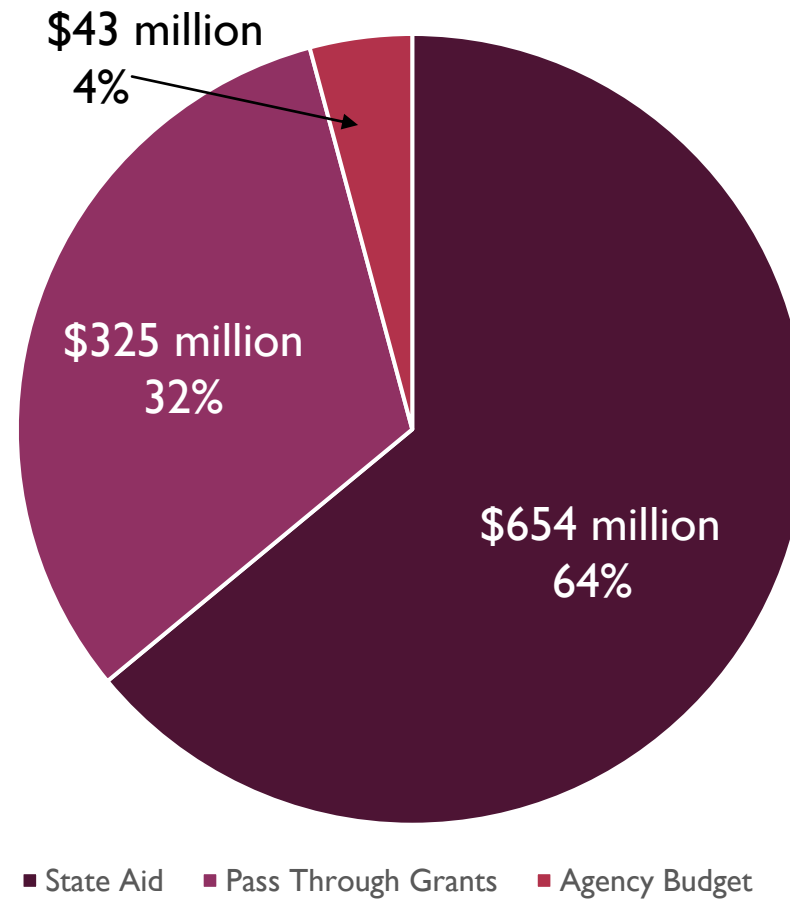

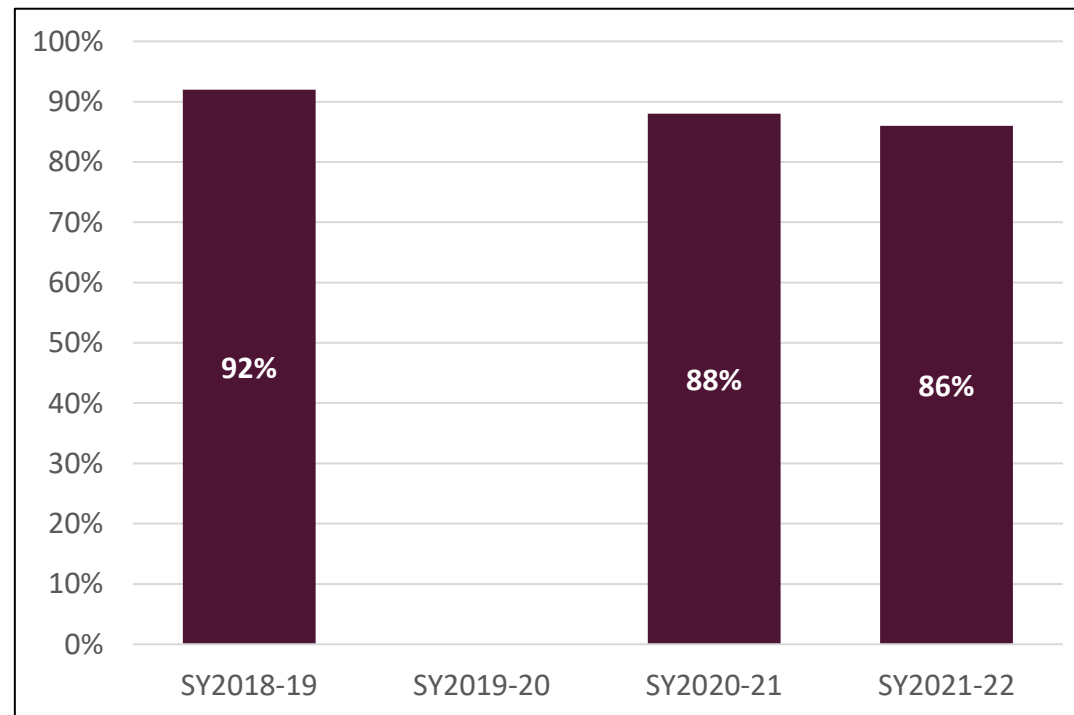

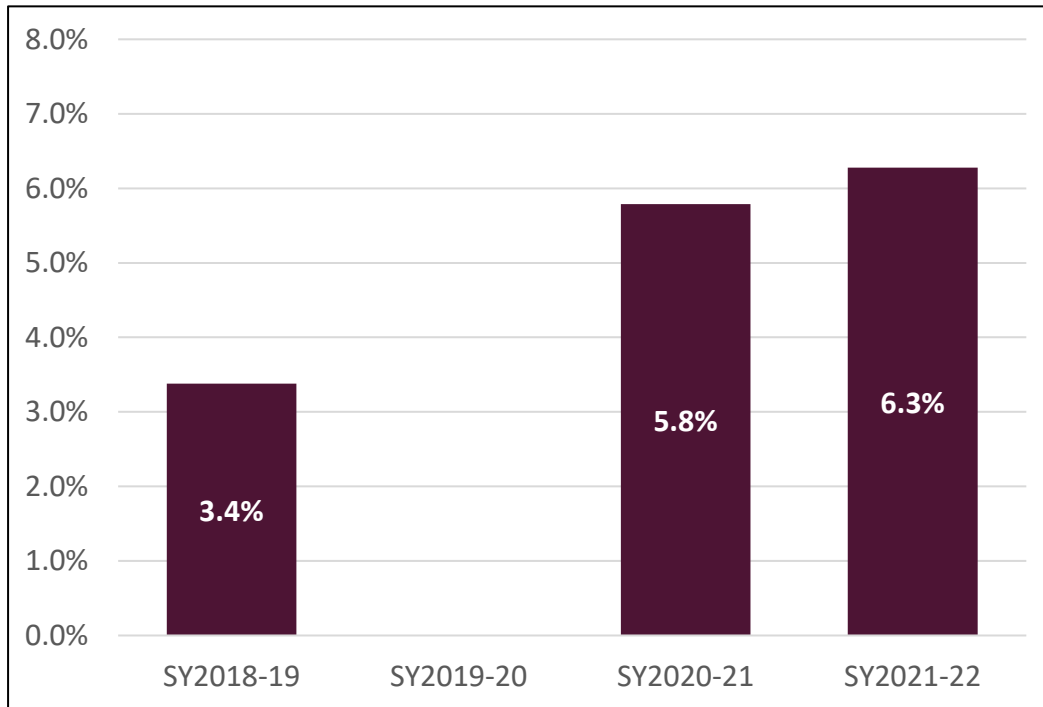
# K-12 ATTENDANCE

## High Absenteeism Rate



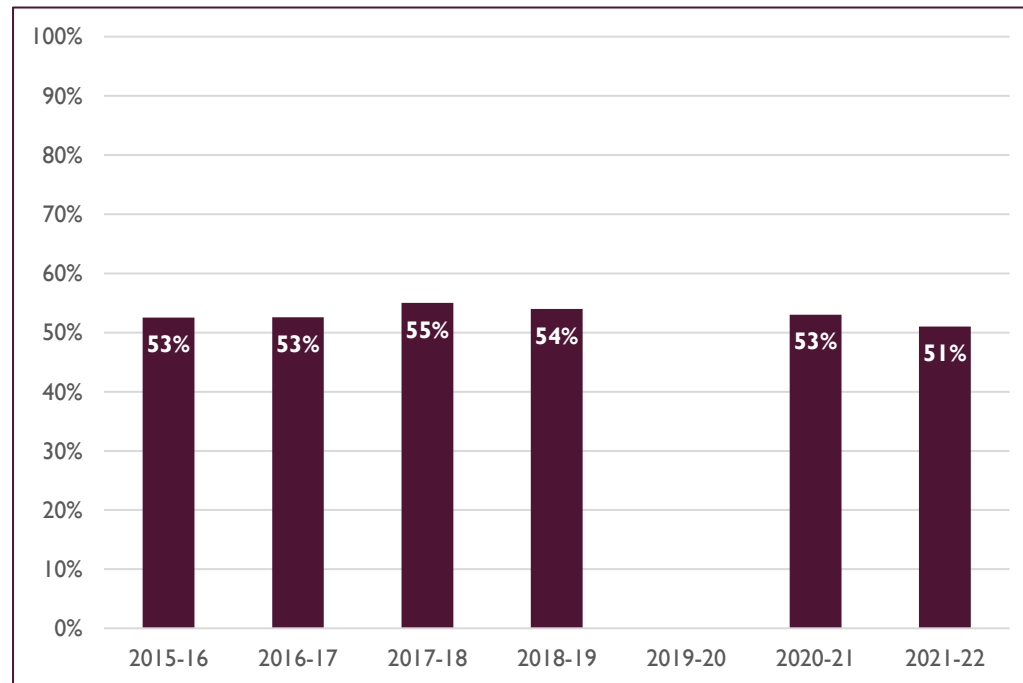

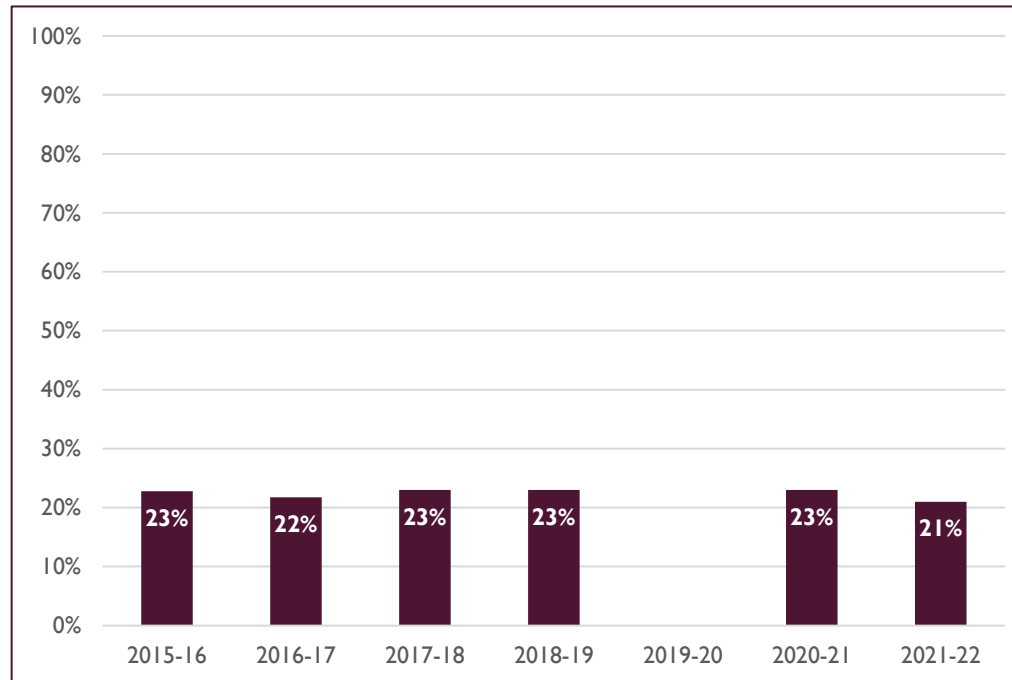

## Proficiency Rate: English Language Arts All Students, All Tested Grades



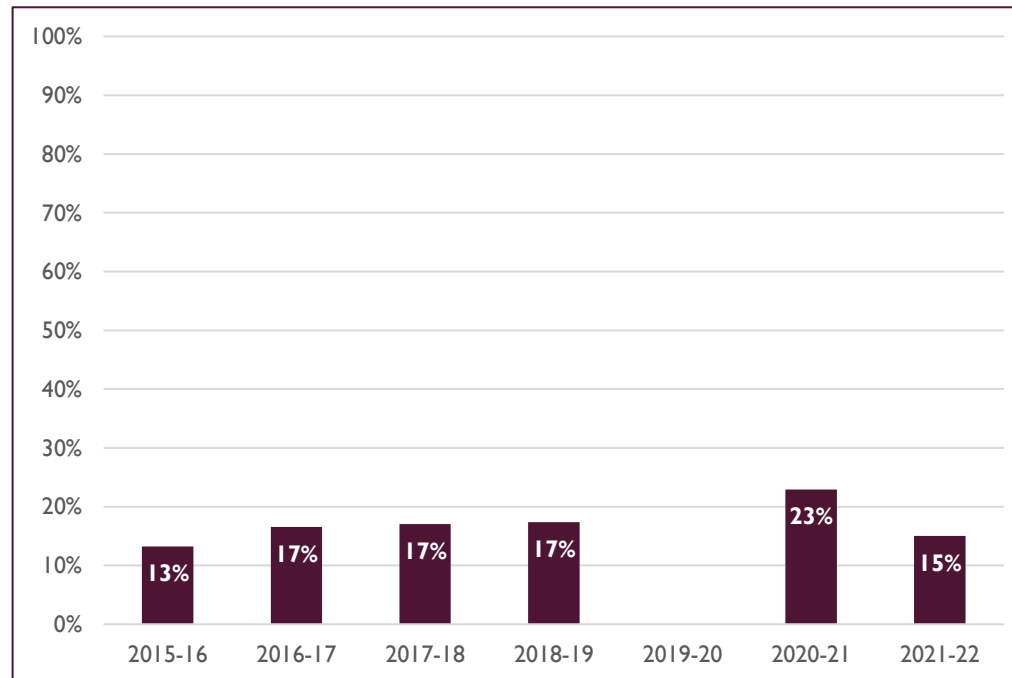

## Proficiency Rate: English Language Arts Native American Students, All Tested Grades



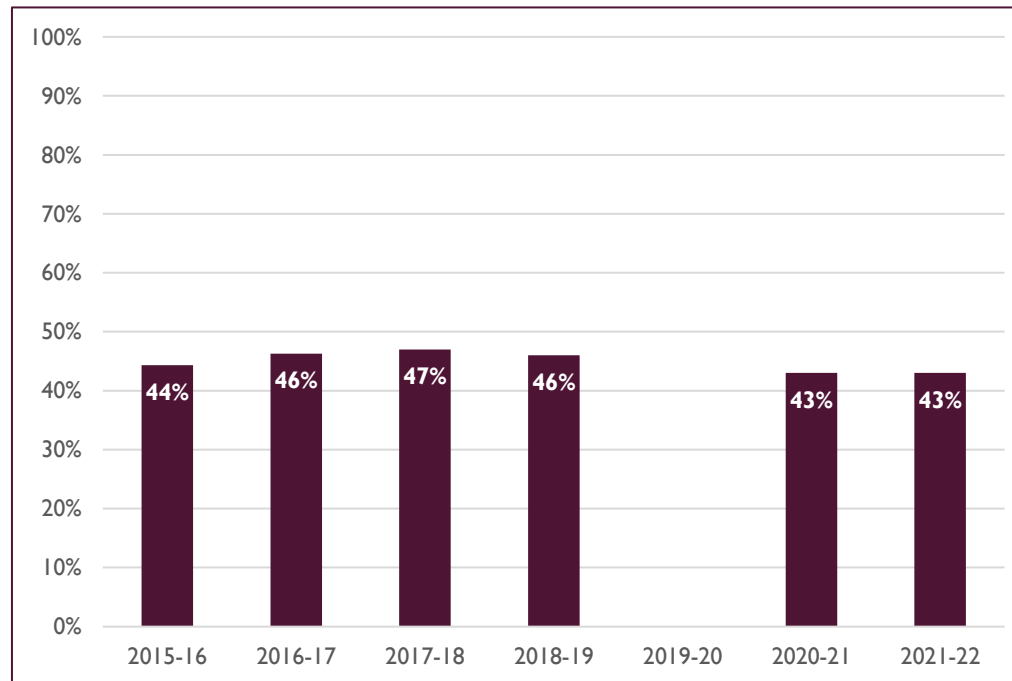

## Proficiency Rate: English Language Arts English Learners, All Tested Grades



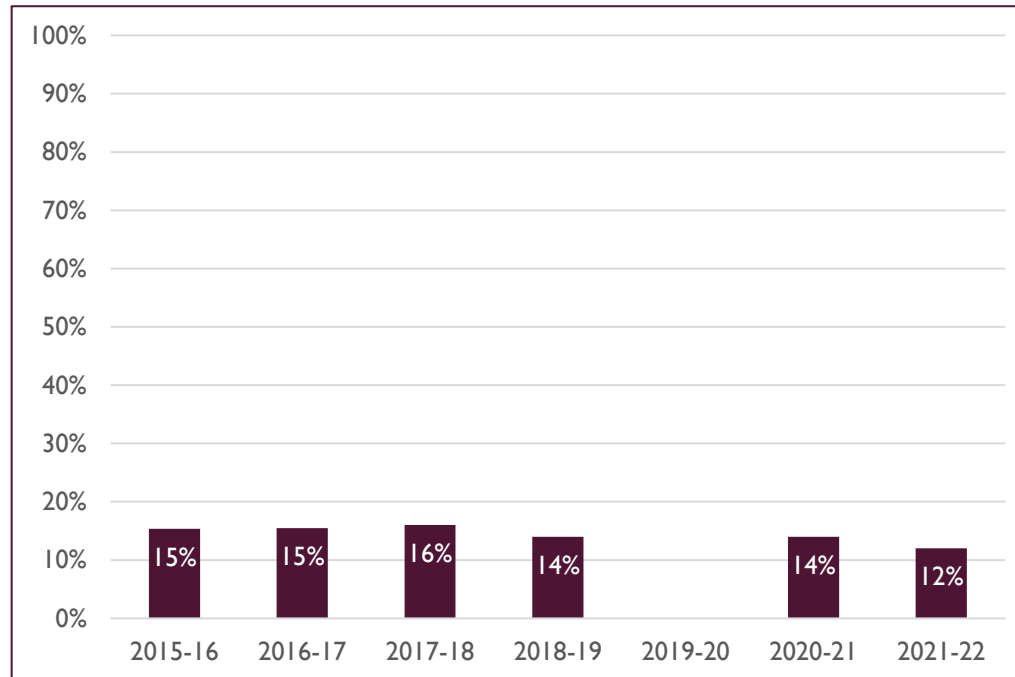

## Proficiency Rate: Math All Students, All Tested Grades



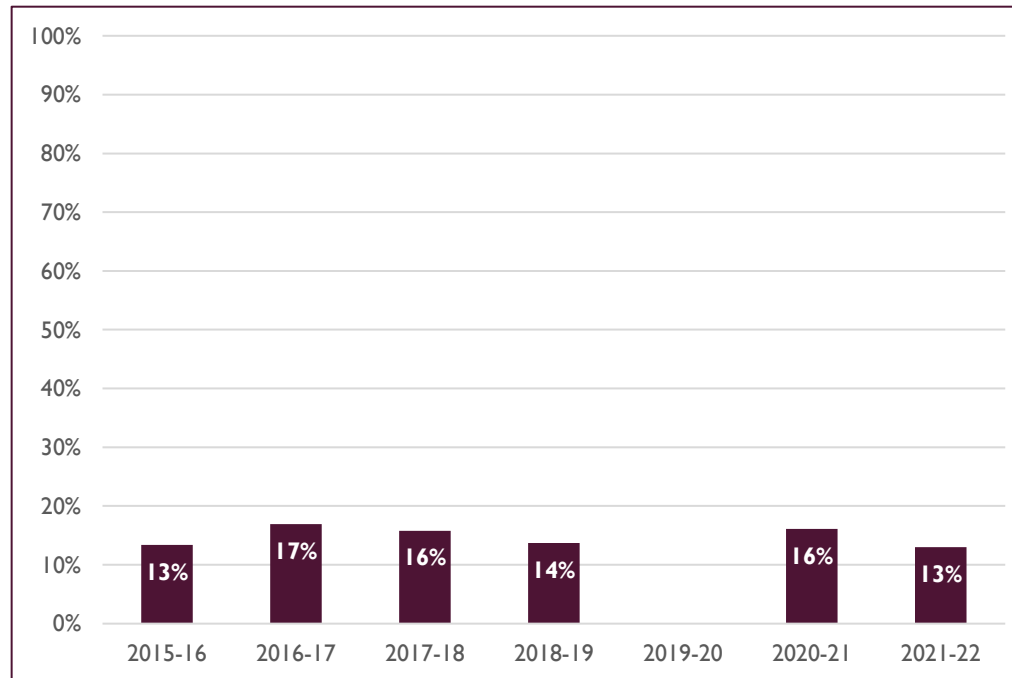

Native American Students, All Tested Grades



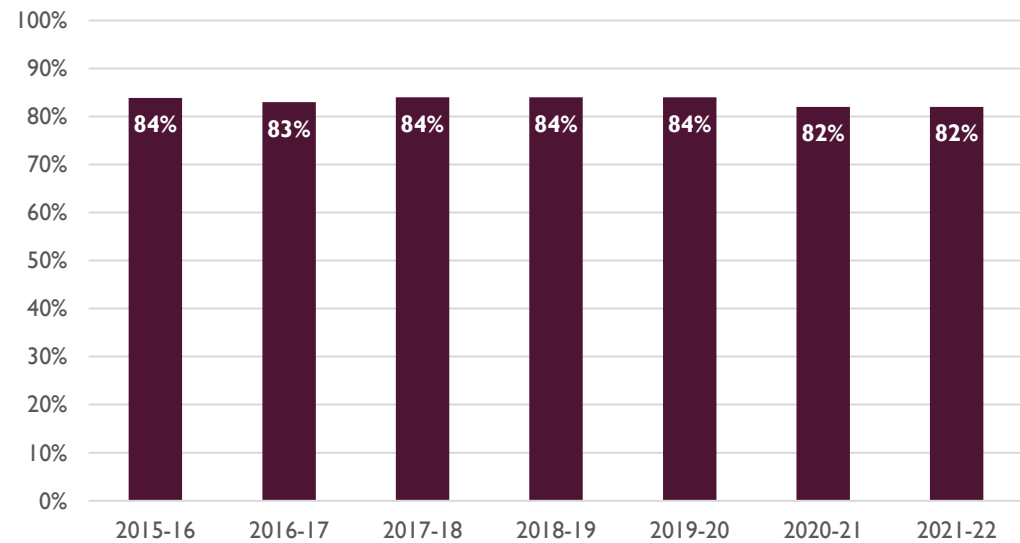

## Proficiency Rate: Math English Learners, All Tested Grades

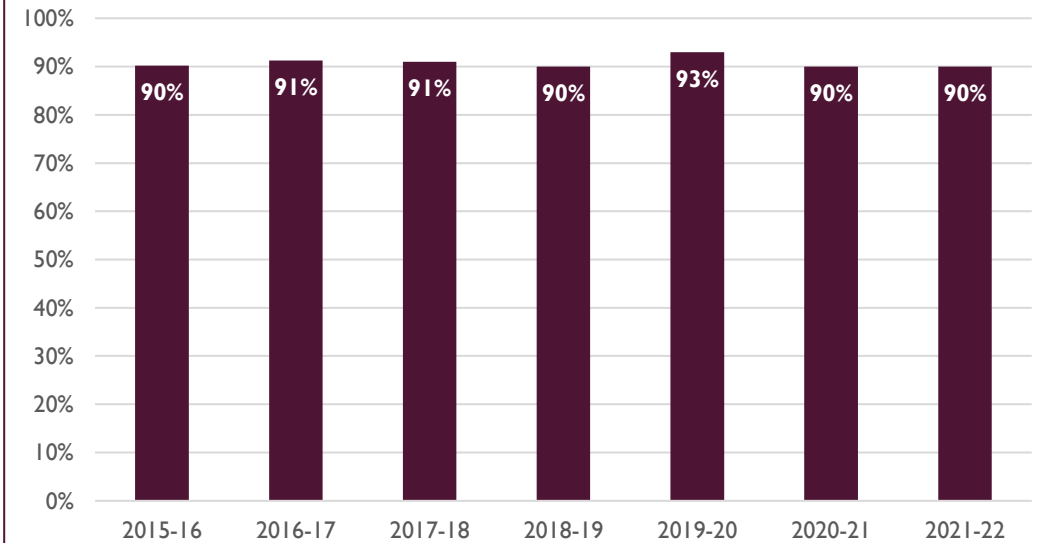

Graduation On-Time Rate -- All Students

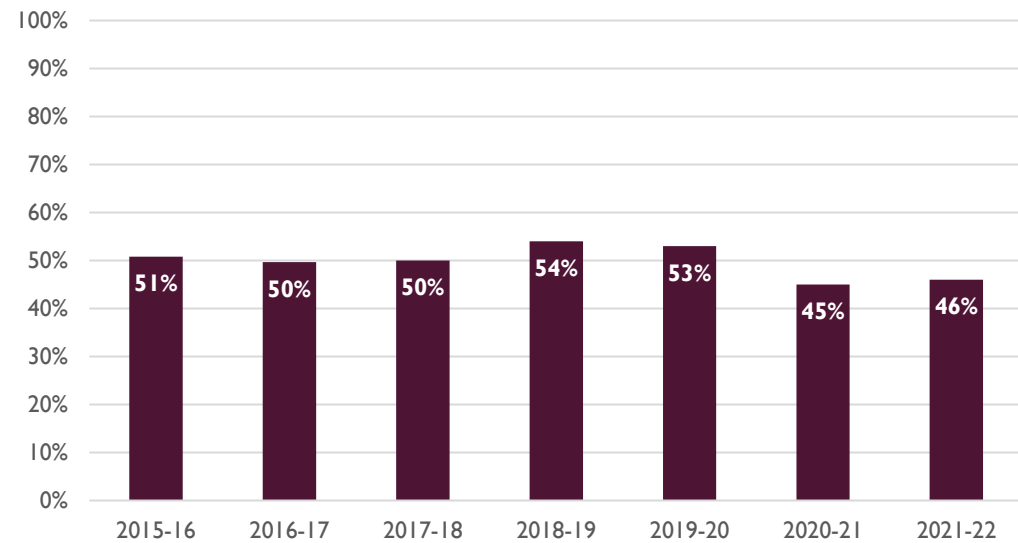


Graduation Completer Rate -- All Students

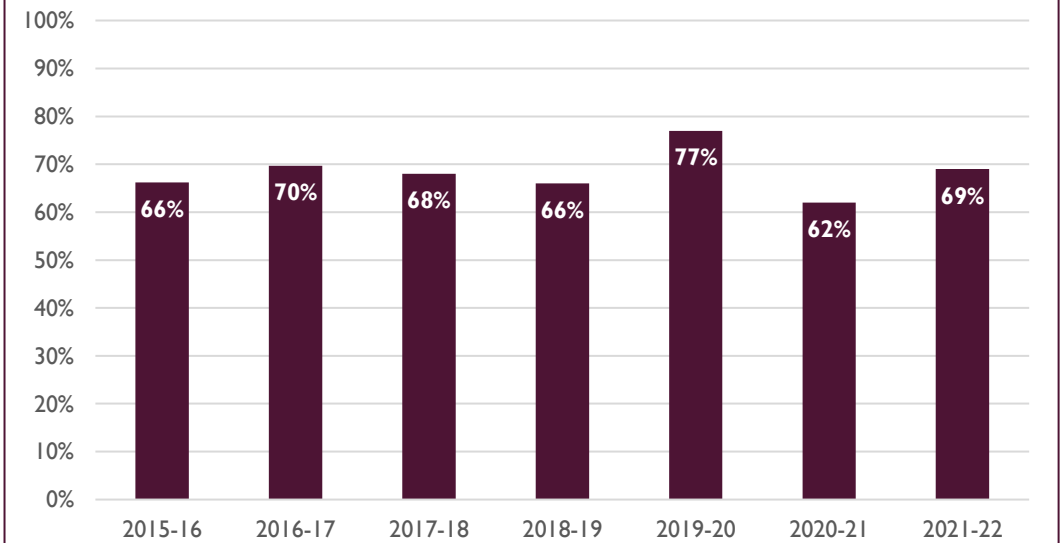

## On-Time Graduation Rate: Native American Students



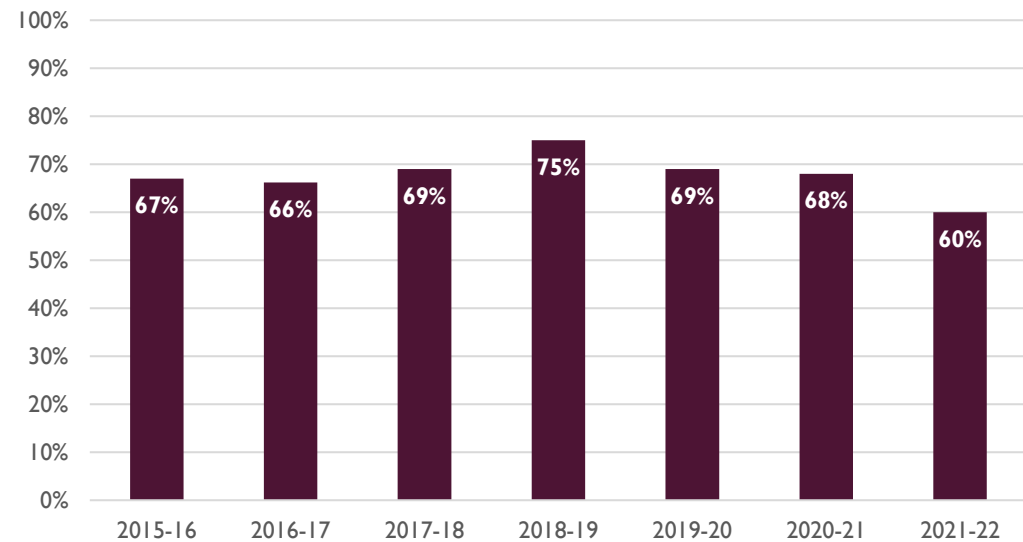

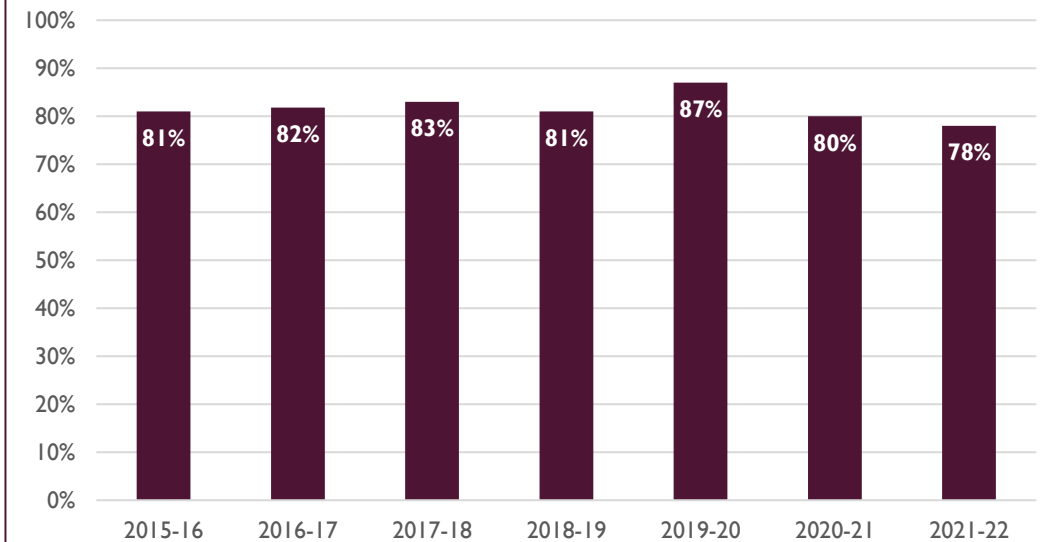

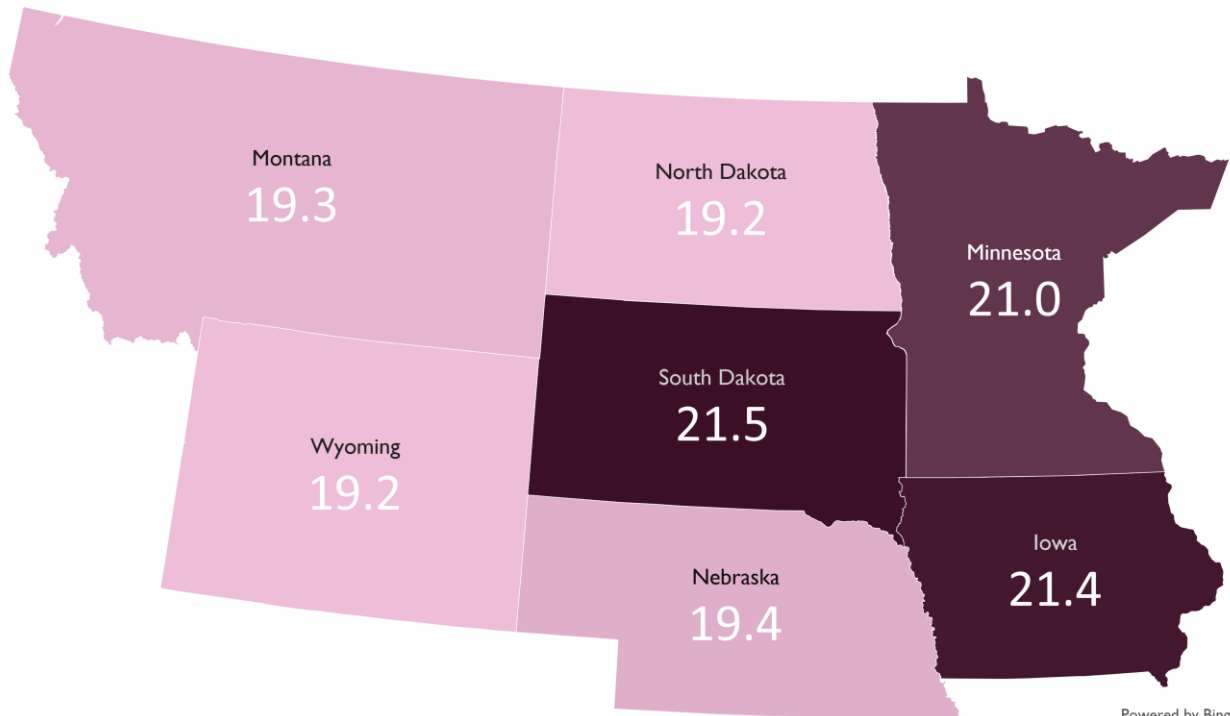

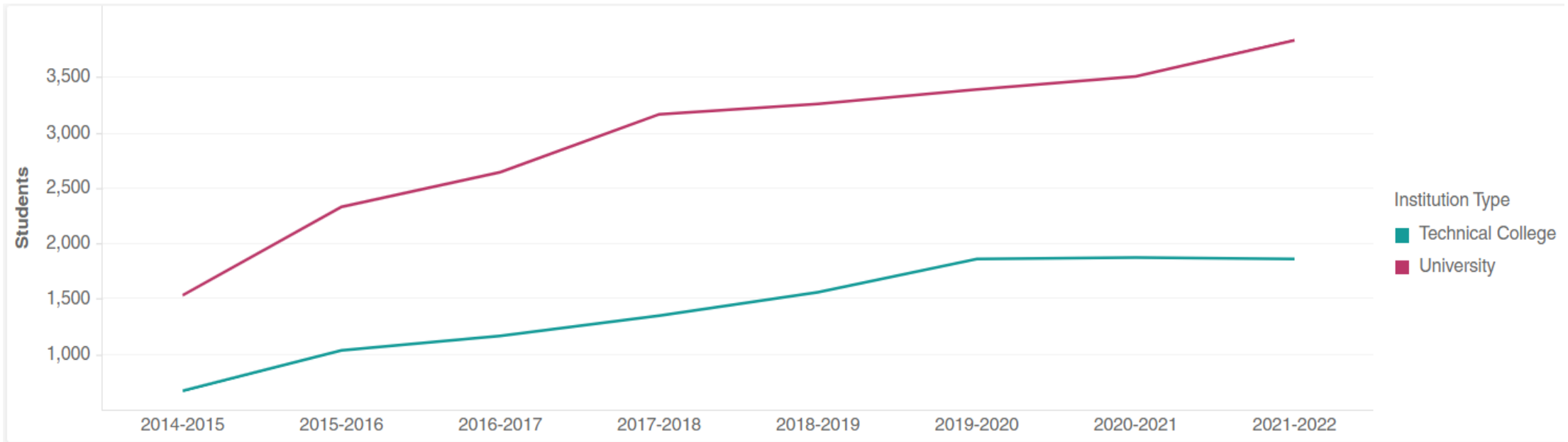

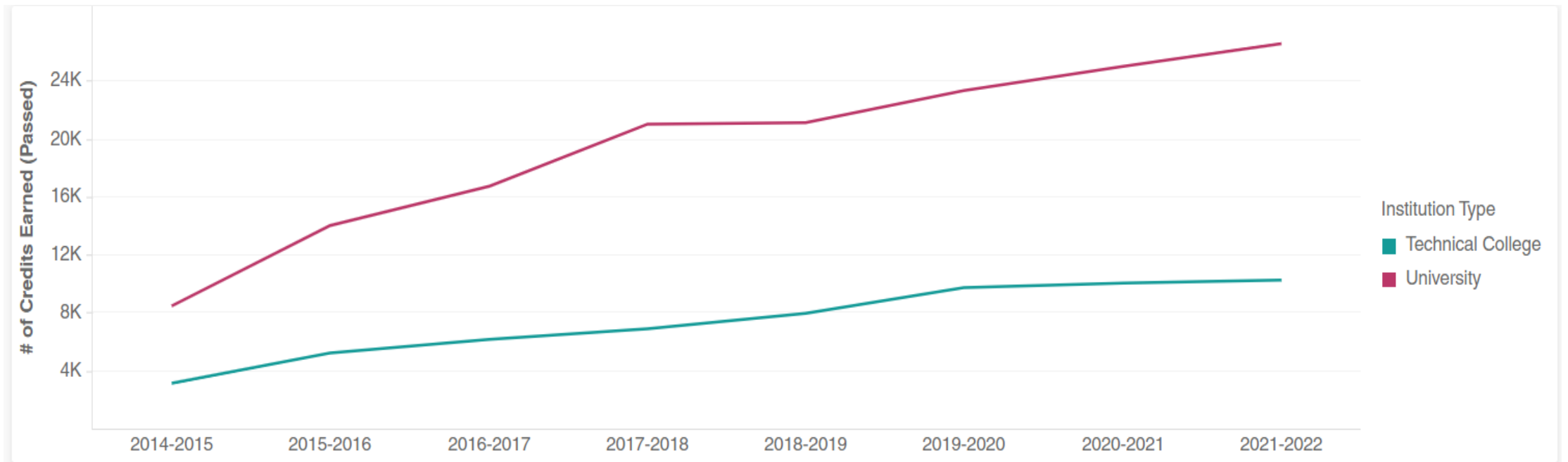
## STATE-SPONSORED DUAL CREDIT PROGRAM

- Open to South Dakota 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders
- 6 public universities; 4 technical colleges
- Institutions agree to reduced tuition rate of \$145 per credit
  - State pays \$96.67
  - Families pay \$48.33
