

Nurturing Speaking Growth

Two-Part Webinar Series with one Self-Paced Module

This eWorkshop is designed to nurture students' growth in speaking, by combining an exploration of the ACCESS for ELLs Speaking Test with teaching practices focused on student engagement and oral language development.

You will engage in three modules:

- **Module 1** delves into understanding common questions regarding the WIDA ACCESS Speaking test. It is not a Speaking test training.
- **Module 2** explores implementing standards-aligned pedagogical practices to increase meaning making
- **Module 3** discusses teacher actions to grow student speaking abilities.

1. Educators who do not administer the ACCESS speaking Test
2. Educators who administer the WIDA ACCESS speaking Test and want to know more about it.
