
## Updates to the Personnel Record Form (PRF) School Year 2024-25

There is a new field on the bus driver collection called "No South Dakota CDL Required (optional)". If one of the below reasons are selected, then the record doesn't have to check for an active South Dakota driver license status.

1. **Drives a 15 or less passenger vehicle:** These were previously part of the classified collection coded as 107 - Special Education Bus Drivers not required to have a CDL. Personnel who provide specialized pupil transportation as per a student's individual education plan (IEP) indicated as transportation as a related service. Personnel is not required to have a CDL due to the vehicle used for transportation purposes (i.e.: small passenger van or car) but must have a valid driver's license.



- As far as those districts that reported a "Classified Individual List" for 2023-2024, we were able to partially crosswalk those records to the 2024-2025 Bus Driver collection. The FTE was just evenly divided between the number of staff records so you will need to double check the FTE.




- As far as those districts that just reported an FTE with no individual records for 2023-2024, you will need to remember to add these staff to the bus driver menu for 2024-2025:




2. **Out of State CDL:** Those with an out-of-state CDL will need to be reported as such to skip the calculation for a valid South Dakota CDL. Most of these were identified as "Not found" in 2023-2024 so we were able to fill in the "out of state CDL" for 2024-2025.



A new assurance statement compliancy statement was added to the PRF sign off on the assurance statement.


• Current Youth Suicide Awareness and Prevention completion certificates are on file for all educators.



Previously the public and coop districts didn't see the adjusted salary calculations converting to the rate of pay to what a full-time person would be making. These calculated figures have been converted to a full-time (1.00) rate of pay to determine reasonableness using the below calculations and now display on the screen as adjusted figures so you can determine whether the FTE or salary is unreasonable based on what you entered:

Total Instructional Salary / Total Instructional FTE

- Total Ed Spec Salary / Total Ed Spec FTE
- Total Admin Salary / Total Admin FTE



As far as running historic data for 2023 and 2024, we are still working on some overrides. Be sure to report any discrepancies.
