In accordance with and pursuant to the authority granted to the Secretary by SDCL § 13-42-4, 13-42-7, and ARSD article 24:18, and after review of the record herein, the Secretary issues the following Order:

- The Secretary accepts the allegations of the Notice of Intent to Deny Teaching Certificate as true
  and enters the attached Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.
- The application of Sandra Ames-Clark for an Out-of-State Initial Application for a teaching certificate is DENIED.
- Sandra Ames-Clark is permanently prohibited from reapplication for teaching certificate in the State
  of South Dakota.
- 4. The Order and Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are a public record pursuant to SDCL § 13-42-17.1 and ARSD 24:18:04:05.
- Notification of this denial is to be placed on the NASDTEC registry and be placed in applicant's permanent certification file within the South Dakota Department of Education.
- Ames-Clark is permanently prohibited from being employed by a public school or other accredited school in South Dakota pursuant to SDCL § 13-43-5.1.

This constitutes final agency action and may be appealed to circuit court pursuant to ARSD 24:18:02:06.

Sandra Ames-Clark filed an Out-of-State Initial Application for a teaching certificate which was activated on March 3, 2021. After a review of the entire file, the Secretary enters the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- On or about June 1, 2021, the South Dakota Department of Education Office of Educator
   Certification (hereinafter "Department") served a Notice of Intent to Deny Educator Certificate and attached exhibits on Sandra Ames-Clark (hereinafter "Ames-Clark") via certified mail and email.
- 2. On or about June 21, 2021, the Department received a request for hearing from Ames-Clark.
- 3. The hearing was scheduled for August 11, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. C.T.
- 4. On or about July 28, 2021, Ames-Clark requested to withdraw her previous request for a hearing.
- Robert B. Anderson, Independent Hearing Examiner, entered an Order Dismissing Request for Hearing. See Exhibit #1.
- 6. On or about March 3, 2021, Ames-Clark filed an Out-of-State Initial Application for an educator certificate. During the process of reviewing the documentation required for the certificate, the Department discovered that Ames-Clark was employed as a teacher for the Pine Ridge school district for school year 2020-2021 without being certified. Ames-Clark's criminal history and the facts surrounding her pending licensure case in Colorado indicate that Ames-Clark has committed numerous acts of moral turpitude over the last 30 years.
- 7. In response to Ames-Clark's application, she disclosed that she pled guilty to destruction of evidence

- and harboring a criminal in Seoul, Republic of Korea. Ames-Clark also disclosed that she did not report her convictions on her licensing or teaching job applications.
- 8. The Department has confirmed the pending case against Ames-Clark's teaching license with the Colorado Department of Education and the Attorney General of the State of Colorado.

## **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 9. Robert B. Anderson was duly designated and appointed as Independent Hearing Officer, pursuant to ARSD 24:18:02:03 by the South Dakota Secretary of Education, and thereby designated to preside over the contested case.
- 10. The Department of Education and, in particular, the Secretary of Education has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter of this proceeding.
- 11. Grounds for the denial or non-renewal of a teaching certificate are provided in SDCL § 13-42.
- 12. The Secretary of the Department of Education has the power and authority to refuse to issue or renew a certificate as provided by SDCL §§ 13-42-7 and 13-42-9.
- 13. Ames-Clark failed to contest the allegations described in the Notice of Intent to Deny.
- 14. The South Dakota Department of Education has met its burden of proof that Ames-Clark engaged in acts that constituted moral turpitude.
- 15. Independent Hearing Examiner affirmed Department of Education's decision to deny the application of Ames-Clark. See Exhibit #1.
- 16. Any Conclusion of Law more properly designated as a Finding of Fact is hereby so designated.
- 17. Ames-Clark's application should be denied for moral turpitude. SDCL § 13-42-9.
- 18. Ames-Clark should be prohibited from reapplication for an educator certificate in the State of South Dakota permanently.
