Nathan V. Tweten filed an alternative preliminary initial application for an educator certificate which was activated on July 28, 2022. After reviewing the entire file, the Secretary enters the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- On or about the August 16, 2022, the South Dakota Department of Education Office of
 Education Certification (hereinafter "Department") attempted to serve a Notice of Intent to
 Deny Educator Certificate and attached exhibits on Nathan V. Tweten (hereinafter
 "Tweten") via email, first class mail, and certified mail.
- 2. In his application, Tweten disclosed that he was convicted in Minnesota of two Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) offenses in 2013 and 2017, respectively.
- Tweten failed to adequately disclose his complete criminal history in South Dakota since 2006,
 as follows:
 - 22-19B-1 (F6) Intimidate or Harass any Person or Group, charged in 2006
 - 22-34-1 (M1) Intentional Damage to Property-\$400-\$1000, charged in 2006
 - 22-34-1 (M1) Intentional Damage to Property-\$400-\$1000, charged in 2006
 - 22-19B-1 (F6) Intimidate of Harass any Person or Group, charged in 2006
 - 22-34-1 (F4) Intentional Damage to Property-\$1000-\$100,000, charged in 2006
 - 22-19B-1 (F6) Intimidate or Harass Any Person or Group, charged in 2006
 - 22-34-1 (M1) Intentional Damage to Property-\$400-\$1000, convicted in 2006
 - 22-18-1 (M1) Simple Assault, convicted in 2006
 - 32-38-1 (PO) Seat Belt Violation, convicted in 2011
 - 32-26-40 (M2) Following too Closely, convicted in 2012
 - 22-18-35 (M2) Disorderly Conduct, convicted in 2014
