Private Report Card Access

There are two types of accountability permissions: school or district. Permissions are assigned by the district's STARS Account Manager. If you have an approved account, you can log in using your K-12 email address and follow the directions that appear to authenticate and log into your K-12 account.

Overall Score Page

The Overall Score Page is the navigation starting point into the report card. From this page, data can be accessed in a variety of ways including (1) drop down menus, (2) the Home or Options menus or (3) the individual white oval indicator links (also called "pills"). These ovals go from white to orange to indicate the page you are currently viewing.



Tools for Validation

Different reports can be found by clicking on View Details and Student Roster. All reports can be exported to Excel. For Student Performance, a drop-down menu allows you to change subjects and choose between participation and proficiency.
