SD-STARS Basics

What is SD-STARS?

- ▶ SD-STARS is...
 - ▶ Statewide Longitudinal Data System (SLDS)
 - ▶ Collects and maintains student- and staff-level data
 - ▶ Links data across entities and over time
 - ▶ Makes data accessible through reporting and analysis tools





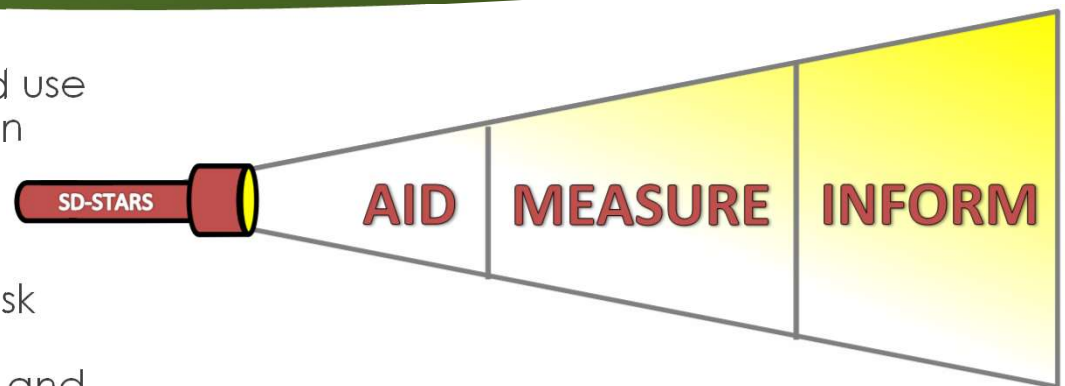
Putting the pictures together is “using data” in a longitudinal environment. This is SD-STARS.

SD-STARS Vision

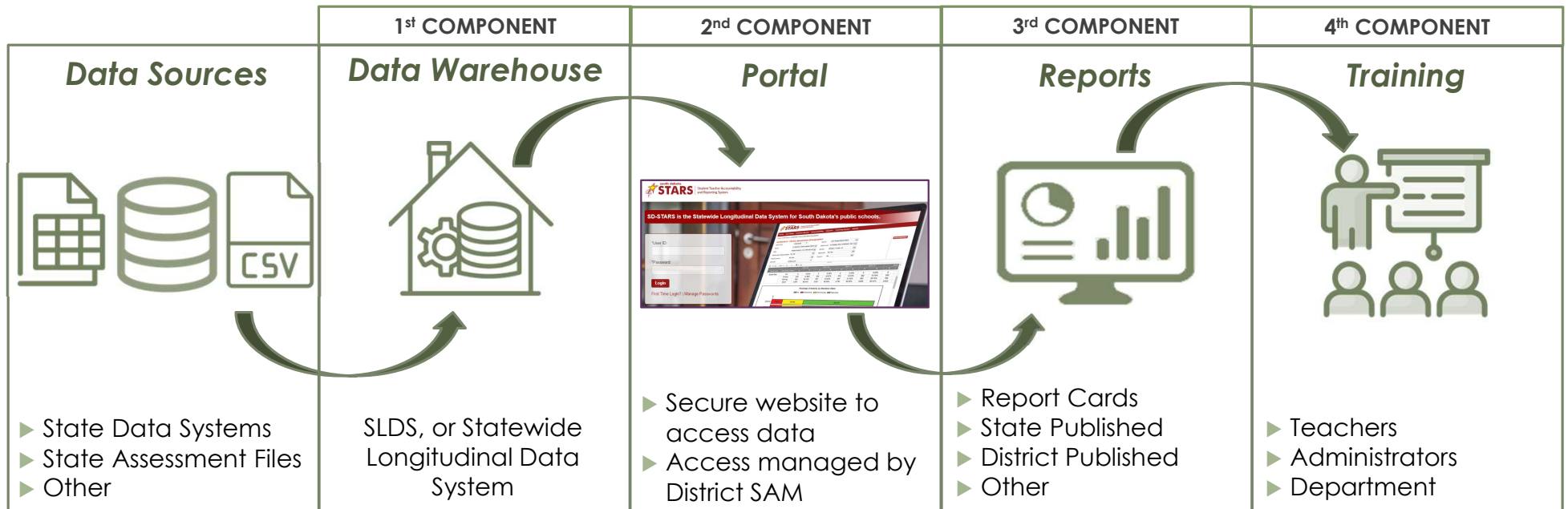
AID: Educators have the ability to access and use high quality data to **aid** in informing instruction and decision-making.

MEASURE: Students' outcomes will be **measured** so educators can identify at-risk students, examine achievement gaps, evaluate programs, recognize strengths, and address areas for improvement.

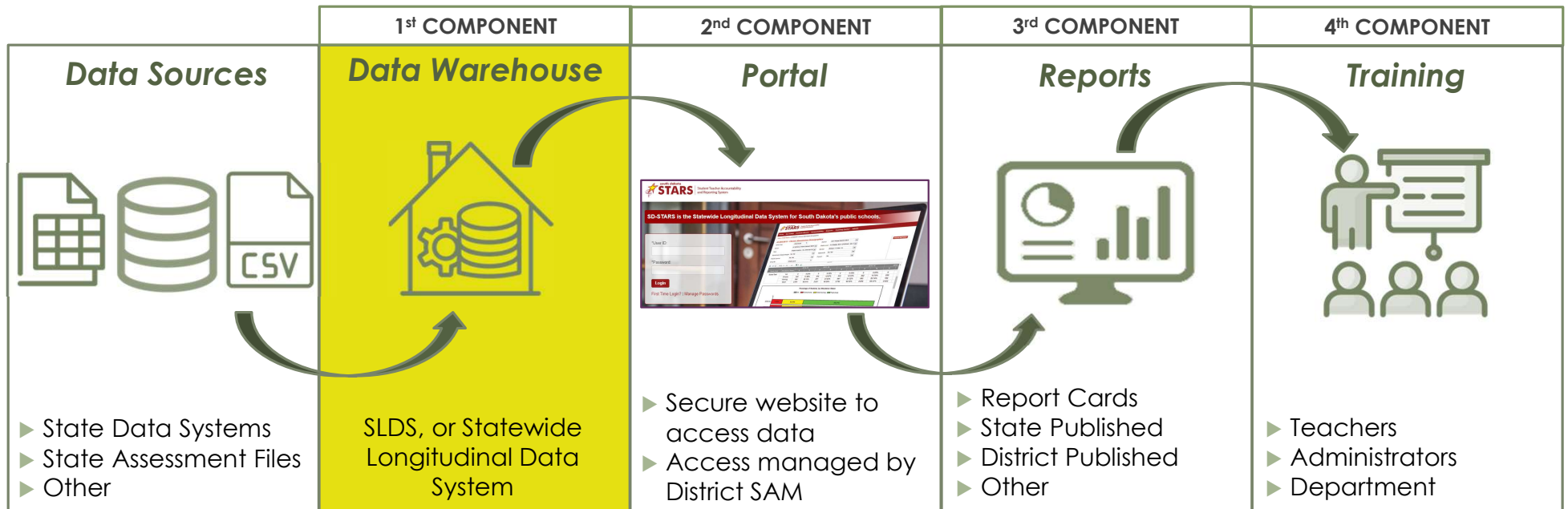
INFORM: Stakeholders will develop a more holistic view of our education system and use that picture to **inform** systemic change.

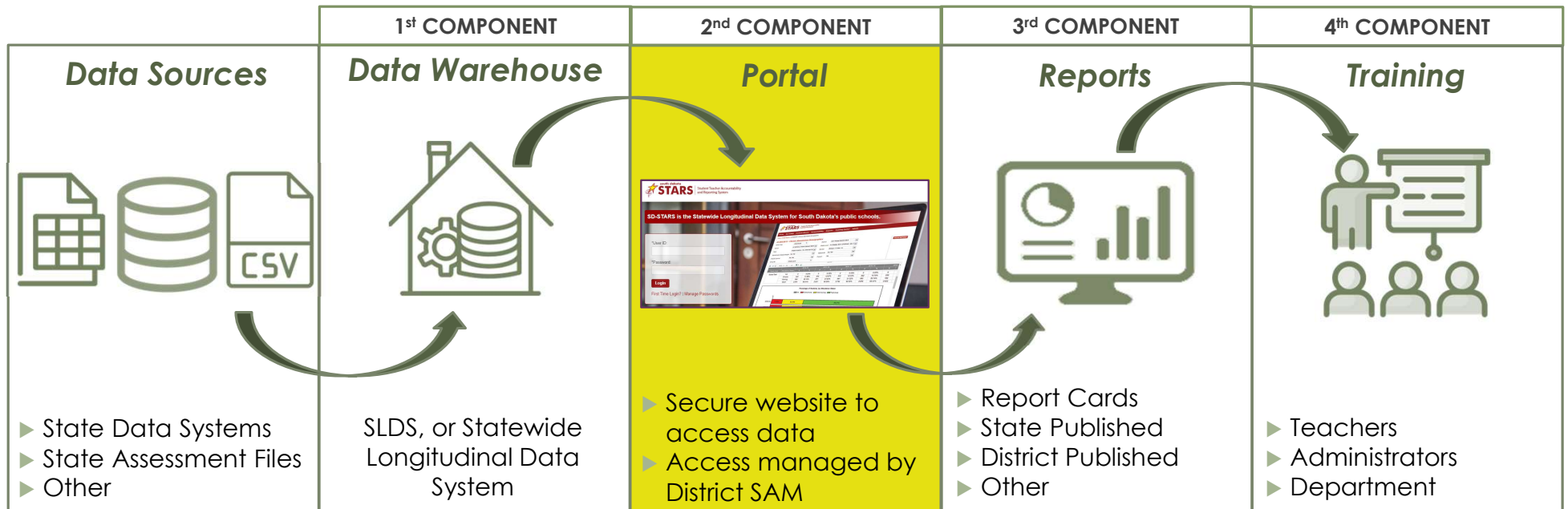

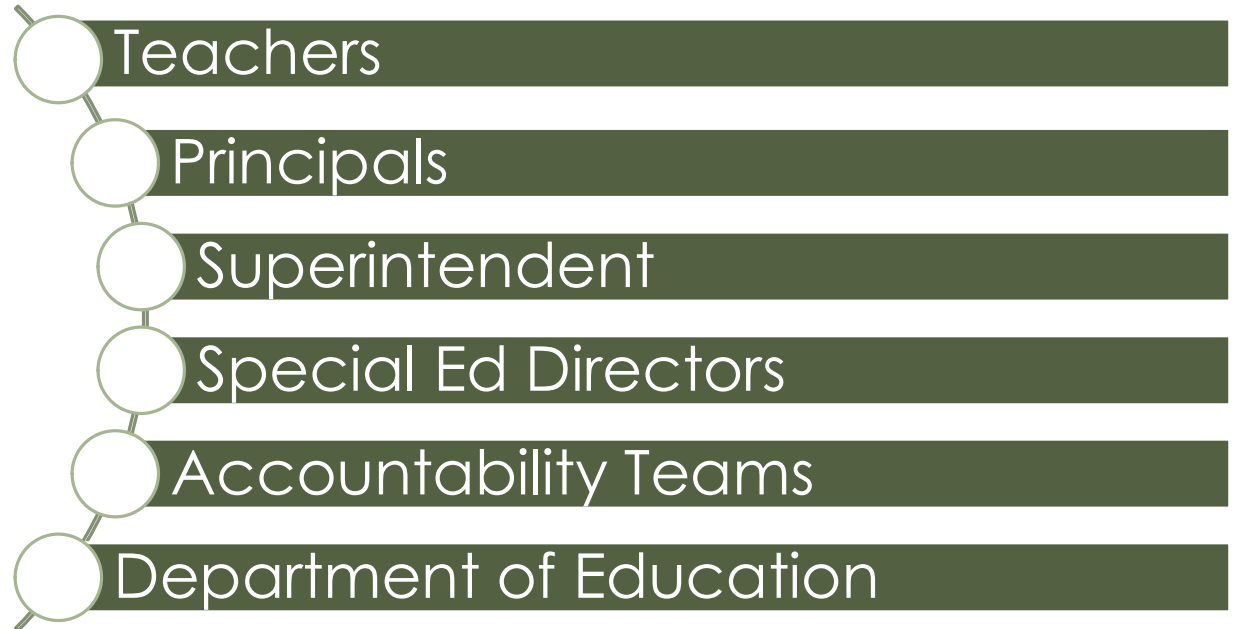

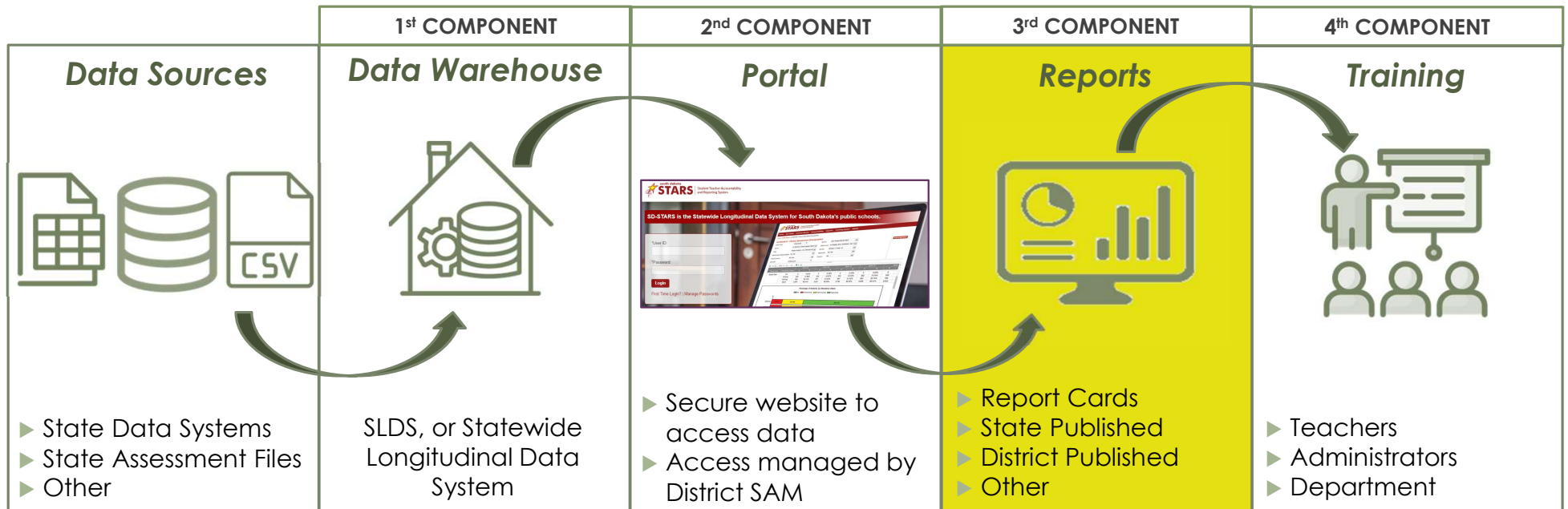


Portal – Secure Website

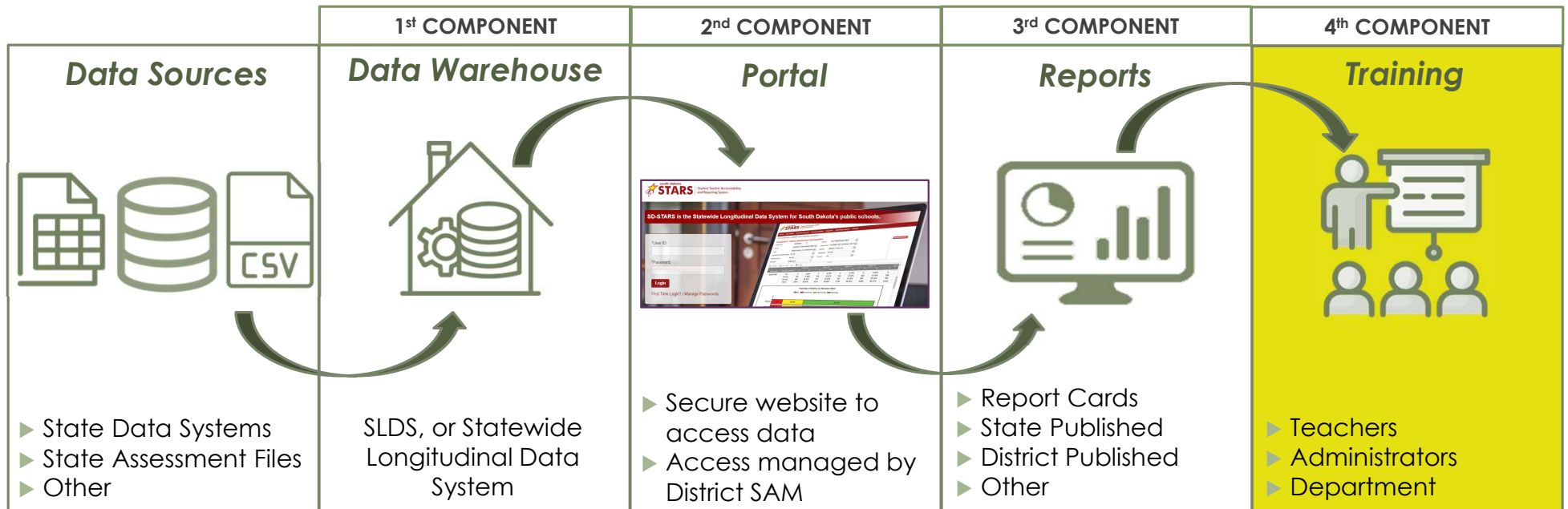

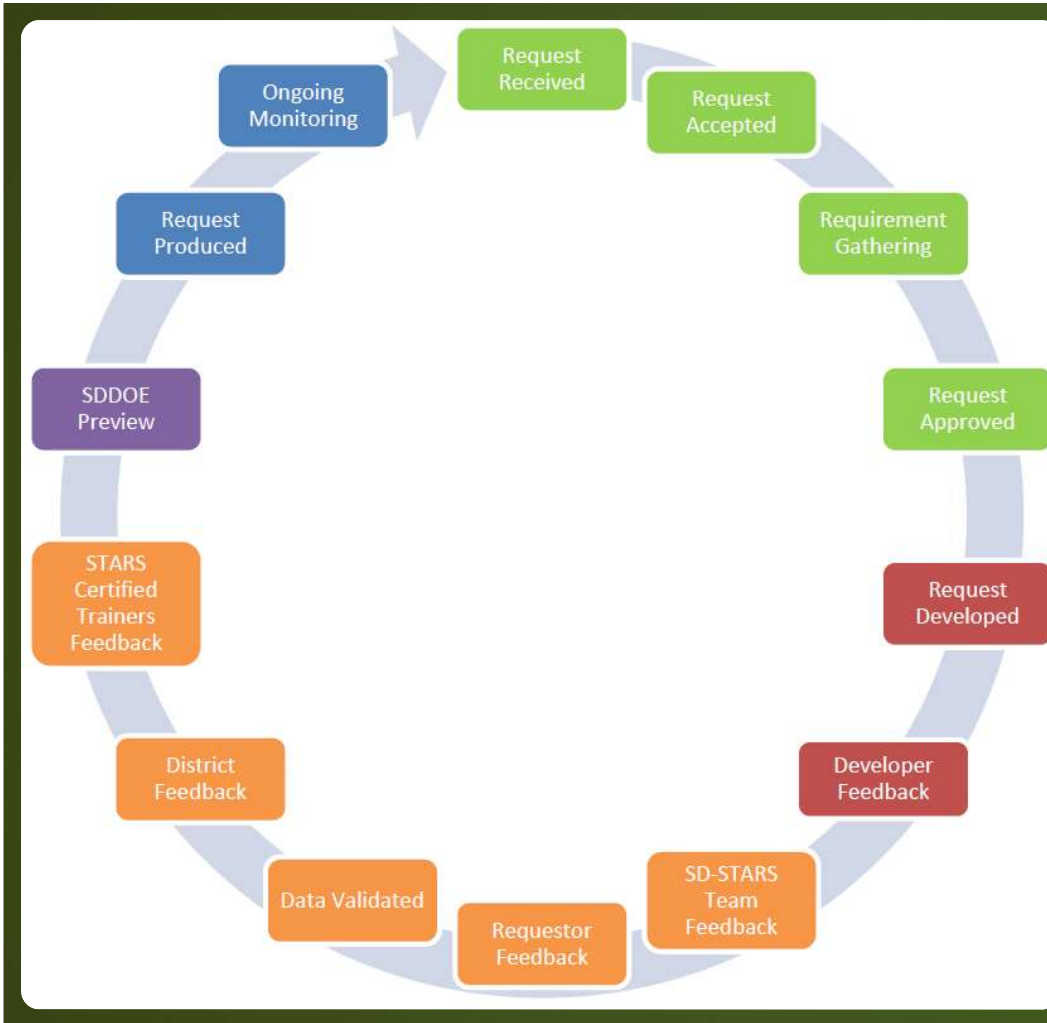

Describe the report you are requesting. How would the report work, and how would it show data?

When I start the school year, I want to know about the attendance of students who are coming into my school. I use this to target specific interventions to students who were chronically absent in prior years. I would like a report that would have all the students enrolled in my school and their historical attendance information. It would be the Student Attendance List but historically, like how the Student Longitudinal Achievement report has every state assessment. For example, an 8th grader would appear on multiple rows – one row for KG, one for 1st, and so on for 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, and 8th. I would also want a filter in the report so that it only gives me rows where the student was chronic, or rows where students were warning. This will be useful for school counselors.

The report will help target kids who were chronically absent in years prior to coming into my school. This will help me see where I can intervene early. To see historical attendance using the current tools is hard. This report will make it easier.

Data details

The attendance calculation uses the **Absent Days** field on the state reporting area on enrollment tab in Infinite Campus. In addition, this report aligns with the Student Attendance List and Student Profile reports.

Common misunderstandings

This report looks at current students and their historical attendance. If the student attended a different South Dakota school¹ in a prior year, the student's attendance for that enrollment will appear. If the student had multiple enrollments in South Dakota schools, the attendance will be the aggregation of all enrollments for that year. If the student did not have an enrollment in any South Dakota school in a prior year, NA will appear.

The attendance in this report is **NOT** the same as the attendance School Performance Index in the Accountability Report Card.

WARNING

¹ This includes non-public (private) and tribal. Often, these districts do not report absent days to the SDDOE. If the district does report absences, the report will reflect this. However, if the district does not report absences, the student will have 100% attendance rate on the report.

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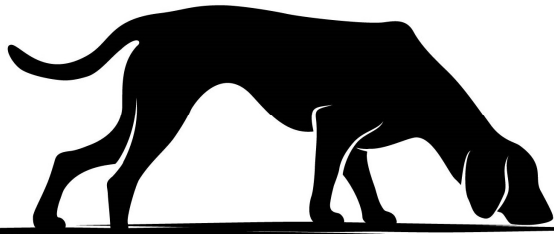
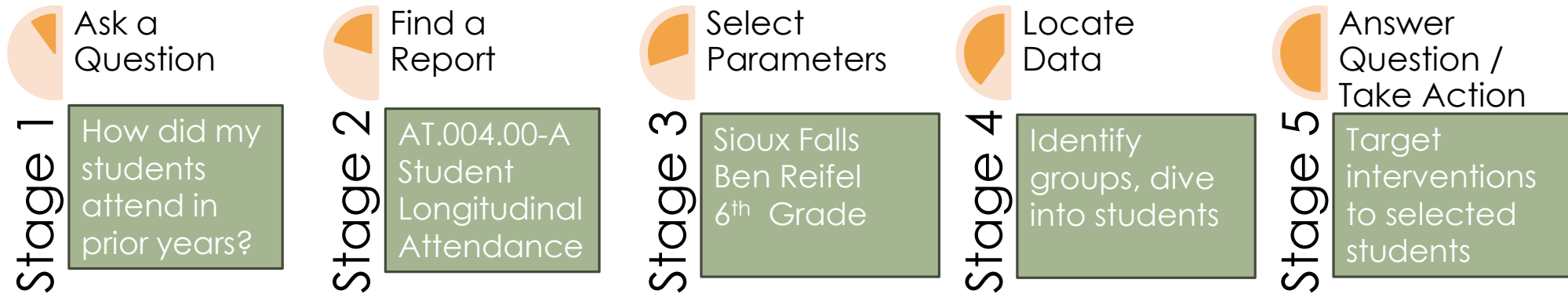
