Subject: Minor Boundary Change Draft Bill

Message: Thank you for the opportunity to comment.

It seems unnecessary for the bill to eliminate all but school board-initiated minor boundary changes and then also put in the requirement that the land being exchanged must be roughly equal in value (within 10%). There are numerous reasons why school boards may want to swap land and we can't think of them all to be able to adequately address all the possibilities in this bill. We should trust that locally-elected school boards will only enter into an agreement that they feel is advantageous to their school district, regardless of whether there is a like-value exchange of land.

The requirement that the fair market value of the exchanged land be within 10% should be eliminated from this bill, as school boards will act in their own best interests and this requirement may interfere. Thanks.

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
