

BDI-3 Program Label Codes

Options	Definitions	Examples (Could be one or more of the following)
Part C Entry	The evaluation represents Entry into the Part C (Birth to Three) program. *Data used for Indicator C3.	- The student was evaluated, found eligible, and is currently receiving Part C services, including Prolonged Assistance. (if less than 6 months of services = 1) - A student's BDI-3 can be used for eligibility if the evaluation is less than 6 months old. However, it cannot be used as the Part B Entry evaluation unless the student was at least 2 years 6 months old at the time the assessment was completed.
Part C Exit	The evaluation represents the student's Exit from the Part C Birth-3 Program. *Data used for Indicator C3.	- Child exits Part C services before transition evaluation for Part B 619 (age 3-5) services. - Child is participating in transition evaluation for Part B services and IS NOT eligible.
Part C Entry /Transition	The evaluation represents Entry into the Part C Program, and the student is eligible for Part B 619 (transition). *Data used for Indicator C3 and B7	Student was evaluated 90 or less days before 3rd birthday due to a LATE Part C referral. Student is determined eligible for Part C services and Part B 619 Special Education and/or related services.
Transition	The student is aging out of Part C and determined eligible for Part B 619. Evaluations represents Exit from Part C and Entry into Part B 619 services. *Data used for Indicator C3 and B7	- Student was evaluated for Part C exit and it is at the time of their 3rd birthday AND they are eligible for Part B 619 services. - The evaluation must have been conducted when the child was 2 years 6 months old or older.
Part B Entry	The evaluation represents the student's Entry into the Part B 619 services. *Data used for Indicator B7	Student is age 3-5 and is not currently receiving Part C services, found eligible for Part B 619 services for the first time and will receive at least 6 months of services. (if less than 6 months of services = 1)
Part B Exit	The evaluation represents the student's Exit from the Part B 619 preschool Special Education program. *Data used for Indicator B7	- Student with a Part B Entry, Part C Entry/Transition, or a Transition evaluation record is turning 6 years of age or exits Part B 619 services early. - Evaluation is given within 90 days of the student's 6th birthday, or at time of exit. - Student with a Part B Entry or Transition evaluation leaves Part B 619 services after 6 months of services. (moves out of state, family declines services, etc.)
0: Ineligible OR Parents Declined Services	The student was determined ineligible for special education services and will not receive Part C or Part B 619 preschool services – OR – the student is eligible, but the parents declined services .	- The student was evaluated for Part C or Part B 619 services and was not eligible. - Student was evaluated for Part C or Part B 619 services and found eligible, but parents declined services.
1: Other—Not for Student Outcomes	The evaluation was conducted for a purpose unrelated to providing entry or exit data for the South Dakota Student Outcomes Measurement Reporting Indicator B7 or Indicator C3.	- The student was evaluated or reevaluated for reasons other than Entry, Transition, or Exit into or out of Part C or Part B 619 services. - The Student was evaluated for internal district progress monitoring or did not or will not receive 6 months of services. - Evaluation conducted on or after the 6th birthday.

Special Notes:

- ✓ Part C refers to students being evaluated or eligible for Birth to Three services.
- ✓ Part B 619 refers to students being evaluated or eligible for Part B services from age 3 through age 5.
- ✓ Program Labels monitor progress by comparing **Entry** and **Exit** scores for students in Part C and Part B 619 programs. These data support Indicator B7 (Part B 619 Preschool Outcomes) and Indicator C3 (Birth–3 Early Student Outcomes). Eligibility may also be established using criteria other than the BDI-3. If a student will not receive 6 months of services before their 6th birthday, BDI-3 **DOES NOT** have to be given.
