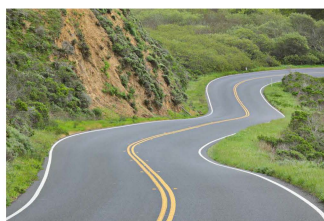

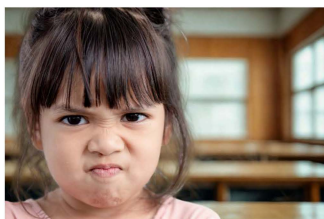
The IEP Journey: A Guide for Parents

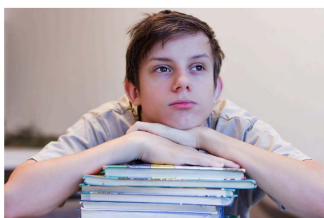
When Behavior is a Concern
