

## 2024-2025 Nonpublic School Proportionate Share Allocations for Equitable Services

The following equitable services proportionate share amounts for Title I Part A, Title I Part C, Title II Part A, Title III, Title IV Part A, and Title IV Part B are estimates based on the FY24 LEA allocations after transfer of funds. Final amounts are determined at the Local Educational Agency (LEA) level through the consultation and budget approval process. Note the following considerations when reviewing the set-asides calculated below:

- Amounts are based on the information the LEA entered into the Grants Management System's consolidated application for program funding.
- Calculations reflect the program amounts after the transfer of funds made by the LEA in and out of each program.
- The amounts reflect any administrative set-asides the public district reserved during the completion of the consolidated application process.
