- Enhance class offerings such as virtual foreign language, art, or music education
- Provide mentoring before or after school in study skills or problem solving
- Host family engagement to inform families of FAFSA mandates
- Provide programming to students that are underserved in STEM
- Promote access to accelerated learning such as dual credit and Advanced Placement classes
- Hosting integrated volunteerism and community involvement
- Strengthen instruction in civics and history by incorporating project-based learning
- Strengthen early learning with opportunities in exploration
- Early Intervention and Response to Intervention strategies
- Invite guest speakers in expert fields such as physicists and ambassadors
- Professional development in any of the above-mentioned areas

- Purchase technological infrastructure
- Purchase technological equipment
- Increase access to blended learning
- Discover, adapt, and share high-quality resources
- Acquire digital creation tools for lesson plans to differentiate and individualize instruction
